RESOLUTION WAIVING, BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT, THE UNINCORPORATED AREA RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT OF SECTION 2-98.7(A)(1) OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND APPOINTING NADJEDA CHERILIEN TO THE PUBLIC NUISANCE ABATEMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, section 2-98.7(a)(1) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida (the "Code"), provides that all members of the County's Public Nuisance Abatement Board "shall reside in the unincorporated areas of Miami-Dade County, provided, however, that the Board of County Commissioners may, by a two-thirds vote of members present, waive this requirement"; and

WHEREAS, the Public Nuisance Abatement Board consists of 13 members 11 of which must be members of the general public, who have outstanding reputations for integrity, civic pride, business or professional ability, and responsibility, with interest or experience in abating public nuisances; and

WHEREAS, Nadjeda Cherilien is a resident of Miami-Dade County, but does not reside in the unincorporated areas of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Nadjeda Cherilien resides in the City of North Miami Beach; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to waive the unincorporated area residency requirement of section 2-98.7(a)(1) and appoint Nadjeda Cherilien to the Public Nuisance Abatement Board; and

WHEREAS, Nadjeda Cherilien will serve on the Public Nuisance Abatement Board as a member of the general public; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Nadjeda Cherilien's resume is attached,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board, by a two-thirds vote of the members present, waives the requirement of section 2-98.7(a)(1) of the Code that members of the Public Nuisance Abatement Board must reside within the unincorporated areas of Miami-Dade County, and appoints Nadjeda Cherilien as a member of the Public Nuisance Abatement Board for a two-year term commencing April 16, 2020.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jean Monestime. It was offered by Commissioner Audrey M. Edmonson , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
