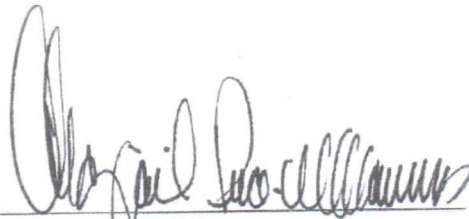

RESOLUTION NO. R-316-20

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE AND GOVERNOR RON DESANTIS TO (1) ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE PANDEMIC PREPAREDNESS PLAN TO COORDINATE ACTIONS TO COMBAT THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) AND ANY FUTURE POTENTIAL PANDEMICS, AND (2) MAKE SUCH PLAN ALL-ENCOMPASSING TO INCLUDE ALL REGIONS IN THE STATE, AS WELL AS COUNTIES, CITIES AND STATE-LICENSED HOSPITALS AND OTHER HEALTH CARE FACILITIES

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2020, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-51, directing the State Surgeon General to declare a Public Health Emergency due to the discovery of the coronavirus disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) in Florida; and

WHEREAS, March 9, 2020, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order No. 20-52, declaring a State of Emergency for the State of Florida due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization determined that the COVID-19 outbreak constitutes a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, the Mayor of Miami-Dade County declared a State of Emergency for all of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a national emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis has directed the Florida Division of Emergency Management to activate to Level II to coordinate the State’s response to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has asked hospitals around the country to activate their emergency preparedness plans, including the delaying of elective procedures to ensure availability of hospital beds; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Health (DOH) has established an Incident Management Team to coordinate response operations in Florida; and

WHEREAS, DOH and the Florida Agency for Health Care Administration have been in communication with hospitals, nursing homes, and assisted living facilities in Florida regarding COVID-19 response activities; and

WHEREAS, this Board urges the Florida Legislature and Governor Ron DeSantis to develop and establish a pandemic preparedness plan to coordinate actions to combat the spread of COVID-19 and any future pandemics at the Florida state, regional, county and city levels; and

WHEREAS, this Board further urges that the pandemic preparedness plan be all-encompassing and that it include pandemic preparedness requirements for all state-licensed health care facilities, including without limitation hospitals, nursing homes and assisted living facilities,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Legislature and Governor Ron DeSantis to establish a statewide pandemic preparedness plan to coordinate actions to combat the spread of COVID-19 and any future potential pandemics. Such a pandemic preparedness plan should be all-encompassing to include all regions in the state, as well as counties, cities, and state-licensed hospitals and other health care facilities, including without limitation hospitals, nursing homes and assisted living facilities.

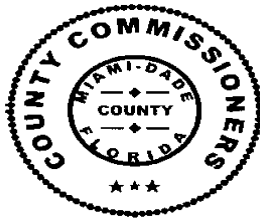
Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, Senate President, House Speaker, the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade Legislative Delegation, the Florida Surgeon General, the Secretary for the Agency for Health Care Administration, and the Director of the Division of Emergency Management.

Section 3. Directs the County’s lobbyist to a dvocate for the legislative action set forth in section 1 above and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2020 State Legislative Package to include this item, and to include this item in the 2021 State Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Audrey M. Edmonson** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
