Subject: Recommendation for Approval to Award a Designated Purchase Contract: Rabies Oral Vaccine Program

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve this request for award of Designated Purchase Contract No. BW-10058, Rabies Oral Vaccine Program, to Boehringer Ingelheim Animal Health USA Inc. (Boehringer) for the Animal Services Department (Animal Services). Approval of a designated purchase is being requested pursuant to Section 2-8.1 (b)(3) of the Miami-Dade County Code to authorize award of a contract to assist Animal Services in preventing the spread of wildlife rabies throughout the County.

On June 2019, Animal Services implemented a three-year initiative for the biannual distribution of rabies vaccines. The oral rabies vaccine baits called "Raboral V-RG" are used to treat raccoons and coyotes that may come in contact with rabies. The baits are placed around dumpsters, lakes and waterways in both rural and inhabited areas.

Competition for the purchase of this vaccine is not practicable at this time because Raboral V-RG is the only rabies vaccine approved by the United States Department of Agriculture, and Boehringer is the sole manufacturer and distributor of this product. Accordingly, it is in the County's best interest to award this Designated Purchase contract pursuant to Section 2.8-1(b)(3) of the County Code to continue distributing Raboral V-RG.

Scope

The scope of this item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact for the initial term, through December 31, 2021 is \$1,536,000. The current contract, E-10013, is valued at \$676,746 for a one year term and expires on April 30, 2020. The allocation requested will allow for distribution of the vaccine for the remaining two years of the program.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DESIGNATED PURCHASE PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-8.1(B)(3) OF THE COUNTY CODE BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT; AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT NO. BW-10058 FOR PURCHASE OF RABIES ORAL VACCINE PROGRAM TO BOEHRINGER INGELHEIM ANIMAL HEALTH USA, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,536,000.00 FOR THE INITIAL TERM THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2021 FOR THE ANIMAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXERCISE ALL PROVISIONS OF THE CONTRACT, INCLUDING ANY CANCELLATION, RENEWAL AND EXTENSION PROVISIONS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-8.1 OF THE COUNTY CODE AND IMPLEMENTING ORDER 3-38

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board finds it is in the best interest of Miami-Dade County to award Contract No. BW-10058 for the purchase of Rabies Oral Vaccine Program to Boehringer Ingelheim Animal Health USA, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,536,000.00 for the initial term, through December 31, 2021 for the Animal Services Department, pursuant to Section 2-8.1(b)(3) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, by a two-thirds vote of the Board members present. Copies of the contract documents are on file with and available upon request from the Internal Services Department, Strategic Procurement Division.

Section 2. This Board authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to exercise all provisions of the contract, including any cancellation or extension provisions, pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-38.

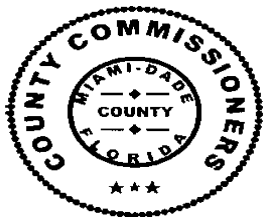
