Subject: Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$384,392.32 to P & J Striping, Inc. for the Project Entitled People's Transportation Plan Pavement Markings Installation; and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds for Such Purposes

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached Contract Award Recommendation for the Project Entitled People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Pavement Markings Installation (Project MCC 7040 Plan - CICC 7040-0/07), Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20190306) in the amount of \$384,392.32 to P & J Striping, Inc. This project was prepared by the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) and is consistent with the ballot language approved by the voters, identified as a project in the PTP Exhibit 1, under Pavement Markings Installation. It can be found in the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust's (CITT) PTP Five-Year Plan Update (<http://www.miamidade.gov/citt/library/five-year-plan/2019/five-year-plan.pdf>, page 25).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Board review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the CITT has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this Contract Award Recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this Contract Award Recommendation, the administration will request a withdrawal of this item.

Scope

Work under this Contract includes furnishing of all supervision, labor, materials, tools, equipment and performing all operations required to construct the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents. Work includes pavement markings and signage of existing and new streets and bike lanes at designated sites throughout the Miami-Dade County maintenance road system.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact of this contract award will be \$384,392.32. The base contract amount is \$297,636, exclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There is no additional fiscal impact to operations or maintenance. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section, and are included in the FY 2019-20 Adopted Budget and Multi-Year Capital Plan under, Volume 2, Department of Transportation and Public Works (Safety Improvements – Countywide, Project P2000000541)

Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

Track Record/Monitor

P & J Striping, Inc., has performed work for DTPW at a satisfactory level. The Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database lists 17 performance evaluations for 17 projects with an average performance rating of 3.5 (satisfactory performance) out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) rating. Among those 17 projects, a minimum score of 3.2 (satisfactory performance) was given to one project and two projects out of the 17 obtained a performance rating of 3.8 (satisfactory performance) out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance). The CIIS and information relevant to this contractor's performance, is available through the Internal Services Department (ISD). The Small Business Development Division (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this contractor. This information is available through SBD's Business Development Reports.

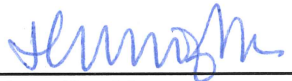
The pavement marking project will be assigned to Joaquin Rabassa, P.E., Project Coordinator, Department of Transportation and Public Works for the day-to-day responsibilities.

Background

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, DTPW continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contracting (MCC) process available under the MCC 7040 Plan. Through this process, DTPW forwards an RPQ to a pool of firms that have registered with Internal Services Department for the respective trade. Additionally, DTPW advertises the project in the Daily Business Review and all solicitations are available on-line through the County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

DTPW forwarded RPQ No. 20190306, utilizing the MCC 7040 Plan, to a list of 66 pre-qualified firms. On January 15, 2020, P & J Striping, Inc. proffered the only responsive and responsible base bid of \$297,636, 0.03 percent below the County's cost estimate. There was no other bidder. Based on the result of the solicitation, DTPW issued a recommendation for award on January 23, 2020 for RPQ No. 20190306 to P & J Striping, Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the Board.

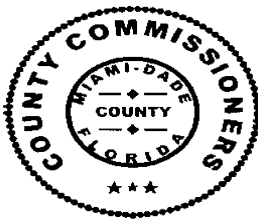
WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute a contract in the amount of \$384,392.32 to P & J Striping, Inc. for the Project entitled People's Transportation Plan Pavement Markings Installation (Project MCC 7040 Plan - CICC 7040-0/07, Request for Price Quotation No. 20190306); authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to exercise all provisions of the contract pursuant to section 2-8.2.7.01 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-53; and authorizes the use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds for such purposes. 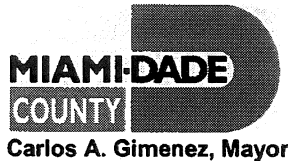

In accordance with Section 2-84.4 of the Code of Miami Dade County, this letter serves to notify you and all bidders on this solicitation that your firm has been recommended for award for the referenced Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) based on the bid submitted on Wednesday, January 15, 2020. Pursuant to the reference legislation, the three (3) day protest period shall commence upon the posting of this recommendation to award. This contract award will be effective only in accordance with the condition of the solicitation, which requires execution by both parties of the Notice to Proceed (NTP).

The value at award is **\$384,392.32**. This includes your base bid amount of **\$297,636.00** a contingency amount of **\$29,763.60** and dedicated allowances totaling **\$56,992.72**. The contract term is established as **365-calendar days**. However, the recommendation of award is contingent upon the submission of the required items listed below:

1. Performance and Payment Bond as required under Article 1.08, Payment and Performance Bonds of the Supplementary Instructions to Bidders. Provide three (3) original sets of the attached document.
2. Letter from Bonding Agent granting Miami-Dade County authorization to date the Performance Bond.
3. Copies of current insurance certificates.
4. Copies of required license(s).
5. Clearinghouse for posting Notice of Job Opportunities as required in Article 1.09 of the Supplementary Conditions.

The preceding documents are required as outlined within the RPQ project specification and the MCC 7040 Plan. They and to be submitted within 10 business days. Failure to submit the document(s) within the specified time, or any extension granted, will result in the award being rescinded.

Subsequent to the review and approval of the aforementioned documents, you are required to obtain the required permits in the time stipulated in the RPQ. Upon obtaining the permit(s), a copy(s) must be submitted to the Project Manager prior to commencement of work. No work is to be performed without a permit unless the Project Manager issues a written directive to proceed without permit(s).

Additionally, please be advised that your firm must have the resources to ensure work proceeds without delay once the "Notice to Proceed" is issued. Lack of equipment, personnel or additional contracts with similar completion schedules, will not be reason for delay.

This letter will also serve as a reminder that this contract is a Small Business Enterprise – Construction (SBE-Con) 100% set-a-side. All construction work must be performed by contractors certified in accordance with Section 10-33.02 of the Code of Miami-Dade County. The scope of work must be performed in accordance with the terms and conditions, all permits and inspections and in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, codes and regulations.

No award of this contract shall be effective and thereby give rise to a contractual relationship with the County unless and until a purchase order for this RPQ has been approved and issued, and a Notice to Proceed has been executed.

SURETY PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND

By this Bond, We _____, as Principal, whose principal business address is _____, as Contractor under the contract dated _____, 20 __, between Principal and Miami-Dade County for the construction of _____ Project No. _____ (herein after referred to as "Contract") the terms of which Contract are incorporated by reference in its entirety into this Bond and _____, a corporation, whose principal business address is _____ as Surety, are bound to Miami-Dade County (hereinafter referred to as "County") in the sum of _____ (U.S. dollars) \$ _____, for payment of which we bind ourselves, our heirs, personal representatives, successors, and assigns, jointly and severally.

THE CONDITION OF THIS BOND is that if Principal:

1. Performs all the work under the Contract, including but not limited to guarantees, warranties and the curing of latent defects, said Contract being made a part of this bond by reference, and in the times and in the manner prescribed in the Contract, including any and all damages for delay; and
2. Promptly makes payments to all claimants, as defined in Section 255.05(1), Florida Statutes, supplying Principal with labor, materials, or supplies, used directly or indirectly by Principal in the prosecution of the work provided for in the contract; and
3. Pays County all losses, damages, including damages for delay, expenses, costs and attorney's fees, including appellate proceedings, that County sustains because of a default by Principal under the Contract, including but not limited to a failure to honor all guarantees and warranties or to cure latent defects in its work or materials within 5 years after completion of the work under the Contract; and
4. Performs the guarantee of all work and materials furnished under the contract for the time specified in the Contract, including all warranties and curing all latent defects within 5 years after completion of the work under the Contract; then this bond is void; otherwise it remains in full force.

If no specific periods of warranty are stated in the Contract for any particular item or work, material or equipment, the warranty shall be deemed to be a period of one (1) year from the date of final acceptance by the County. This Bond does not limit the County's ability to pursue suits directly with the Principal seeking damages for latent defects in materials or workmanship, such actions being subject to the limitations found in Section 95.11(3)(c), Florida Statutes.

Any changes in or under the Contract Documents and compliance or noncompliance with any formalities connected with the Contract or the changes does not affect Surety's obligation under this Bond.
