RESOLUTION URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO INCLUDE FUNDING FOR COMPANIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IN FUTURE STIMULUS PACKAGES OR OTHER MONETARY STIMULUS MEASURES TO ASSIST WITH THE ECONOMIC DOWNTURN CAUSED BY CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)

WHEREAS, at the April 7, 2020 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made urging the United States Congress to include funds in future stimulus packages or other monetary stimulus measures to assist companies and local governments affected by coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19") retain employees by providing paid leave, wage subsidies, and other compensation and benefits,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the United States Congress to include funding for companies and local governments in future stimulus packages or other monetary stimulus measures to assist with the economic downturn caused by COVID-19, similar to stimulus packages funded by countries such as Australia, Canada, France, the United Kingdom, and many others.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this resolution to the members of the Florida Congressional Delegation and the Secretary of the United States Department of Health and Human Services.

Section 3. Directs the County's federal lobbyists to advocate for the action set forth in section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2020 Federal Legislative Package to include this item and to include this item in the 2021 Federal Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner Audrey M. Edmonson , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
