RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO REVIEW AND SUBMIT TO THE BOARD А RECOMMENDATION REGARDING A PROPOSAL FROM SANTA'S ENCHANTED FOREST, INC. TO OPERATE A HOLIDAY-THEMED, TEMPORARY FAIR AT TROPICAL PARK IN NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER, 2020, AND TO ADVISE THIS BOARD IN WRITING WITHIN 30 DAYS WHETHER THE MAYOR FINDS THAT IT IS IN THE COUNTY'S BEST INTEREST TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND PROCEED WITH SUCH A PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, Santa's Enchanted Forest, Inc. ("Santa's") has operated a holiday-themed

light display and temporary fair at Tropical Park for 37 years ("Santa's Enchanted Forest"); and

WHEREAS, in the spirit of the Christmas season, this Board wishes to see the holiday

light display continue in 2020; and

WHEREAS, Santa's contract with the County expires in March 2020; and

WHEREAS, the County is currently in the process of preparing a solicitation for future

uses at the location in Tropical Park currently used by Santa's, which solicitation will include

holiday-themed events; and

WHEREAS, the competitive solicitation process may take several months; and

WHEREAS, the lead time necessary for Santa's to put in place an event for the 2020 holiday season may necessitate more time than afforded due to the competitive solicitation process; and

WHEREAS, Santa's desires to, and is in a unique position to, operate its event at Tropical Park in 2020 while the County finalizes its competitive solicitation process, contract negotiation and contract award; and

WHEREAS, Santa's has proposed to continue operation of Santa's Enchanted Forest in 2020 so as to allow the County to complete its competitive solicitation process; and

WHEREAS, to contract with Santa's for the 2020 season requires that the Mayor issue a written recommendation that it is in the County's best interest to waive competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to have the County Mayor review and consider Santa's proposal to operate a holiday-themed, temporary fair at Tropical Park during the months of November and December, 2020, and advise this Board in writing whether the Mayor finds that it is in the County's best interest to waive competitive bidding and proceed with such a proposal,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are approved and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor to review and consider Santa's proposal to operate a holiday-themed, temporary fair at Tropical Park in November and December, 2020, and advise this Board in writing within 30 days of this resolution whether the Mayor finds that it is in the County's best interest to waive competitive bidding and proceed with such a proposal. The County Mayor shall consult with the District 10 Commissioner before making his recommendation.
