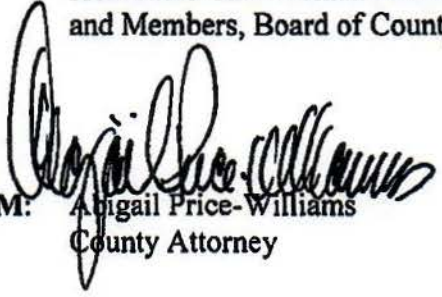

RESOLUTION NO. R-673-20

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO FULFILL THE REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTION NO. R-1117-15, REQUIRING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO COLLABORATE WITH SCHOOLS TO DEVELOP A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE EDUCATION PROGRAM AND REQUIRING A REPORT

WHEREAS, domestic violence is a vicious and pervasive social problem, destabilizing families and threatening every sector of the community; and

WHEREAS, education is crucial to encouraging children to report domestic violence and to break deep-rooted patterns and cycles of abuse; and

WHEREAS, this Board has a long history of addressing domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-1117-15 on December 1, 2015, directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to seek collaboration with the Miami-Dade County School Board and private and charter schools in providing a domestic violence education program to elementary, middle and high school students; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-1117-15 described the proposed program featuring separate classes for boys and girls and including topics relating to how to identify domestic violence triggers, control violent impulses, and recognize and report signs of abuse, among others; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-1117-15 directed the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to research resources with which to launch the program and to report back to this Board with a plan for funding and implementing the program within 90 days; and

WHEREAS, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee has not returned to this Board with the report required by Resolution No. R-1117-15; and

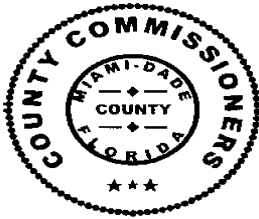
WHEREAS, this Board desires to direct the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to fulfill the requirements of Resolution No. R-1117-15,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to fulfill the requirements of Resolution No. R-1117-15, which requires that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee (1) seek collaboration with the Miami-Dade County School Board and private and charter schools to provide a domestic violence education program to elementary, middle and high school students, with certain features detailed in the resolution; (2) identify resources with which to launch the program; and (3) report back to this Board with a plan for funding and implementing the program within 90 days. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to place the completed report in compliance with Resolution No. R-1117-15 on an agenda of this Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65 within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Vice Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa and the Co-Sponsors are Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava, Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson, Commissioner Sally A. Heyman, Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan and Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
