Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the accompanying resolution authorizing the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to issue a new Miami-Dade County stevedoring license to Evangelia Monocandilos pursuant to Chapter 28A, Section 28A-6 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.

Scope

PortMiami is located within District 5, which is represented by Commissioner Eileen Higgins. The impact of this agenda item is countywide as PortMiami (Port) is a regional asset and generates employment for residents throughout Miami-Dade County.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This proposed resolution will have no fiscal impact on PortMiami.

Delegated Authority

In accordance with Section 2-8.3 of the Code of Miami-Dade County requiring disclosure of delegations of Board authority contained in the body of contracts recommended for competitive award, this item contains no such delegations.

Track Record/Monitor

The Port staff member responsible for monitoring compliance with terms of license is Basil A. Binns, II, Assistant Port Director.

Background

Chapter 28-A, Section 28A-6, of the Miami-Dade County Code, mandates that applications for new County stevedore licenses be presented to the Board by the Mayor, after examination of the qualifications of the applicants by the Seaport Director, and after completion of a background investigation by the Miami-Dade Police Department.

Staff has reviewed the qualifications of the applicant for issuance of a new County stevedore license and determined that she is qualified in accordance with Code licensure requirements of Chapter 28A, Section 28A-6 of the Code. An investigation of the applicant by the Miami-Dade Police Department has revealed no record of criminal activity as outlined in Chapter 28-A of the Code. The applicant has also provided the mandatory bond (attached).

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Evangelia “Lina” Monocandilos is a shipping executive based in Miami, Florida with 10 years of experience in the shipping and logistics industry.

She received her formal business education at Boston University’s School of Management graduating in 2006 with a Bachelor’s degree in Business Administration and a concentration of studies in Operations and Technology Management and Entrepreneurship. While Lina was “born into” the family shipping business, working most summers in various capacities, she began what she calls her “practical” education in June of 2006 and when she joined Bernuth, occupying a desk in the corner of her father’s office.

What had begun as a stevedoring and warehousing operation on the Miami River in 1972 by Lina’s father, Captain Jordan Monocandilos, had evolved into a group of auxiliary companies with a Liner service to the Caribbean Islands, Guyana, Suriname, Nicaragua and San Andres at the core. While Lina learned the ins and outs of the core business, she became increasingly involved with the operational side of the auxiliary services, a trucking company, repair facilities for the vessels, trucks, chassis, and containers, a warehousing and consolidation division, port operations and stevedoring, and the vessels and their management.

During the six years that followed, alongside her responsibilities as Executive Vice-President of Bernuth Lines, Lina would take over the day to day operations and management of the vessels, the trucking, repair, and warehousing divisions and the St. Maarten market where the company also had an office. In 2012, when Bernuth sold the Liner division to King Ocean Services, Lina joined the company. She was instrumental in the integration of the Bernuth services and managed the warehousing and consolidation operations for the combined services until her departure in 2014.

Since 2014, Lina has returned to family business and currently manages the family’s landholdings and marine terminal along the Miami River.
