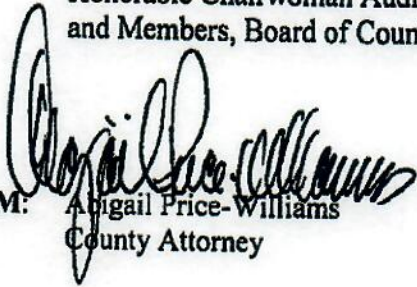

RESOLUTION NO. R-675-20

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT REGULAR INSPECTIONS, INCLUDING PRE-HURRICANE SEASON INSPECTIONS, OF COUNTY PARKS, REMOVE ANY MATERIALS THAT COULD CAUSE DAMAGE/HARM DURING A STORM, INCLUDING EQUIPMENT AND DANGEROUS ELECTRICAL MATERIALS, DISCOVERED DURING SUCH INSPECTIONS THAT COULD CAUSE DAMAGE/HARM DURING A STORM AND REMOVE ANY TRASH AND DEBRIS DISCOVERED DURING SUCH INSPECTIONS

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (“PROS”) currently manages an inventory of 272 parks across Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, there may be items left behind by park vendors and visitors that could pose a danger to park visitors; and

WHEREAS, hurricane season is fast approaching and it is of upmost importance that the parks throughout the County are prepared for the hurricane season; and

WHEREAS, discarded items in parks pose a hazard especially during hurricane season; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires that County parks are kept in a tidy, clean, and safe manner for the enjoyment of all park visitors; and

WHEREAS, inspections by PROS staff would facilitate identifying any potential hazards and allow PROS staff to immediately remedy any such hazards,

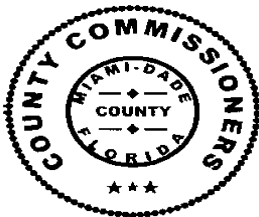
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department to conduct regular inspections, including

pre-hurricane inspections, of County parks, remove any materials, including equipment and dangerous electrical materials discovered during such inspections that could cause damage/harm during a storm, and remove any trash and debris discovered during such inspections.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
