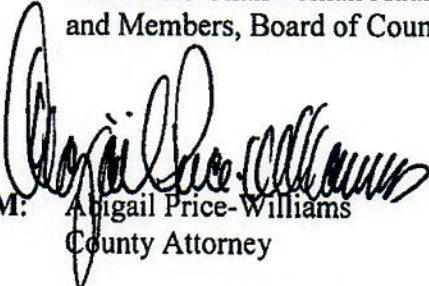

RESOLUTION NO. _____ **R-671-20**

**RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO
APPLY ONE MONTH'S SECURITY DEPOSIT FEE TO THE
PERMIT FEES DUE FOR THE LAST MONTH OF A BERTH
PERMIT AT COUNTY MARINAS FOR BERTH PERMITTEES
AS A RESULT OF CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)**

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department ("PROS")
operates six county marinas; and

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2020, the Mayor amended Executive Order 06-20, closing all
County Marinas as a result of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, due to the closure of County marinas, berth permittees were not able to access
their boats; and

WHEREAS, some of the berth permittees may be facing financial hardship as a result of
COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, as part of the berth permits, permittees are required to pay the equivalent of
2 month's fees as a security deposit; and

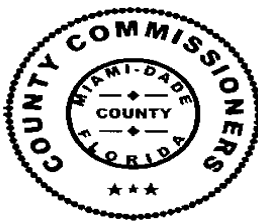
WHEREAS, this Board desires that in order to relieve some financial hardship, PROS
should apply one month's portion of the security deposit paid by permittees to the permittee's last
month's fee at the time the permit expires,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board directs the
County Mayor to apply one month's portion of berth permittee's security deposit to the final
month's payment for berth permits at County marinas. Permittees shall be notified in writing
regarding this change in policy.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
