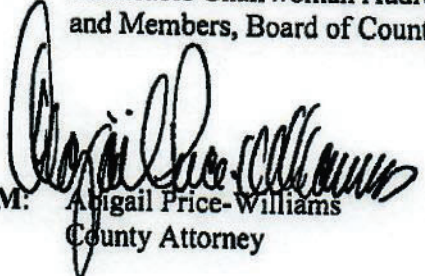

RESOLUTION NO. R-596-20

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FY 2019-20 DISTRICT 4
ALLOCATION OF FEES COLLECTED FOR ISSUING
PARKING PERMITS FOR PERSONS TRANSPORTING
YOUNG CHILDREN AND STROLLERS TO MIAMI
LIGHTHOUSE FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY
IMPAIRED, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000.00

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 13-11 provides that one-third of fees collected for issuing parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers shall be distributed to private not-for-profit, non-denominational agencies providing services for severely abused or neglected children on a countywide basis, throughout all of Miami-Dade County, for a countywide purpose; and

WHEREAS, Miami Lighthouse for the Blind and Visually Impaired, Inc. is a private 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, non-denominational entities that serves children countywide and is dedicated to providing services to severely abused or neglected children; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Implementing Order 4-100, each time that one-third of the fees collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers equals \$130,000.00, each Commission district shall be apportioned \$10,000.00 for allocation (“stroller allocation”); and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade County to provide funding in the amount of \$10,000.00 Miami Lighthouse for the Blind and Visually Impaired, Inc.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

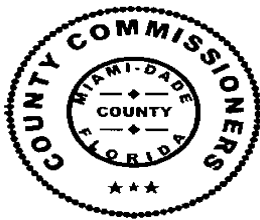
Section 1. The foregoing recitals are approved and incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2. This Board hereby approves an allocation to Miami Lighthouse for the Blind and Visually Impaired, Inc. in the amount of \$10,000.00 and directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to distribute funds collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers as provided herein from the FY 2019-20 District 4 stroller allocation.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Sally A. Heyman. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
