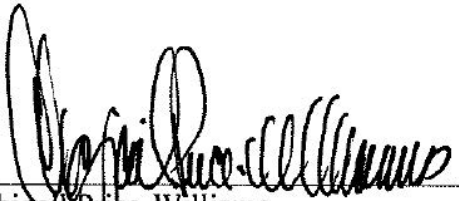

RESOLUTION NO. R-618-20

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF
SOUTHWEST 16 STREET FROM SOUTHWEST 77 AVENUE
TO SOUTHWEST 82 AVENUE AS “MANOLO FERNANDEZ-
CANO STREET”

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2020, Manolo Fernandez-Cano passed away at the age of 94;
and

WHEREAS, since immigrating from Vinales, Cuba to Miami, Florida in 1962, Mr.
Fernandez-Cano dedicated his life to public service and advocating for the Hispanic community
in Miami-Dade County (the “County”); and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fernandez-Cano served as Special Assistant to former City of Miami
Mayor and County Commission Vice Chairman Maurice Ferré; and

WHEREAS, as Special Assistant, Mr. Fernandez-Cano interfaced between community
leaders and entrepreneurs to request funding and grants for educational programs; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fernandez-Cano worked with County Clerk of Courts Marshall Ader as
a Community Liaison Officer, and as such, he facilitated communication among various County
agencies and organized seminars to inform the community of County court programs; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fernandez-Cano also served as Assistant to the Advisor to the Hispanic
Affairs Advisory Board of the County Community Relations Board; and

WHEREAS, while working for the Community Relations Board, Mr. Fernandez-Cano
assisted in the development of Hispanic leadership roles and legislation supporting the Hispanic
community; and

>>WHEREAS, Mr. Fernandez-Cano’s final assignment before retiring at age 92 was that of aide to County Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro, and Mr. Fernandez-Cano served in that role for many years; and

WHEREAS, as a commission aide, Mr. Fernandez-Cano assisted numerous constituents with public housing, assisted in advising County officials on issues impacting intergroup relations, and helped create a cohesive community by valuing and respecting all; and<<¹

WHEREAS, County Mayor Carlos Gimenez and former County Mayor Carlos Alvarez honored Mr. Fernandez-Cano through several proclamations, including the naming of October 12, 2015 as “Manolo Fernandez-Cano Day”; and

WHEREAS, for over 47 years, Mr. Fernandez-Cano resided on Southwest 16 Street in Westchester; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Southwest 16 Street between Southwest 77 Avenue and Southwest 82 Avenue is a County maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to honor the legacy of Mr. Fernandez-Cano by codesignating this portion of Southwest 16 Street as “Manolo Fernandez-Cano Street”,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

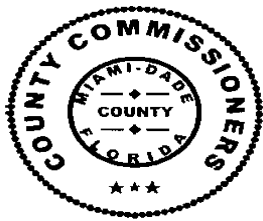
Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates the portion of Southwest 16 Street from Southwest 77 Avenue to Southwest 82 Avenue as “Manolo Fernandez-Cano Street”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Transportation and Public Works Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto and the Co-Sponsors are Commissioner Sally A. Heyman and Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
