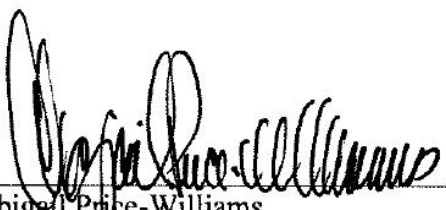

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION URGING THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION, UNITED STATES CONGRESS, AND UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT, TO RECONSIDER DEPORTING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IF THEIR UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE CHOOSES TO IMPLEMENT AN ONLINE-ONLY CURRICULUM AMID THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, at the July 8, 2020 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made urging the Trump Administration, United States Congress, and United States Department of Homeland Security, United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) to reconsider deporting international students if their university or college chooses to implement an online-only curriculum amid the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Trump Administration, United States Congress, and ICE to reconsider deporting international students if their university or college chooses to implement an online-only curriculum amid the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic.

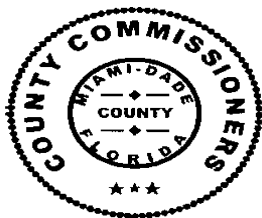
Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this resolution to United States President Donald J. Trump, the President Pro Tempore of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the Miami-Dade County Congressional Delegation, and the Deputy Director performing the duties of the Director of ICE.

Section 3. Directs the County’s federal lobbyists to advocate for the actions set forth above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2020 Federal Legislative Package to include this item and to include this item in the 2021 Federal Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jean Monestime and the Co-Sponsors are Commissioner Levine Cava, Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson, Commissioner Sally A. Heyman, Commissioner Eileen Higgins, Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan, and Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner **Jean Monestime** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Daniella Levine Cava** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
