Subject: Recommendation for Approval of the Use of Up To \$945,000 in Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds for Push Button Intersections Improvements - North (20200031)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the use of Charter County Transportation Surtax (Surtax) Funds for the Intersection Improvements Projects listed in the attached Exhibit B as part of Neighborhood Infrastructure Improvements Projects. This contract is currently approved for the use of non-Surtax funding sources via the Miscellaneous Construction Contracts (MCC) Program and, with this item, the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) is seeking approval for the use of Surtax funding for those roadway improvement projects included within the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) as approved by individual Commissioners.

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this Contract Award Recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this Contract Award Recommendation, the administration will request a withdrawal of this item.

Scope

This contract has been previously awarded under the MCC Program, with a scope of work consisting of intersection improvements throughout Miami-Dade County. A Detailed Scope of Work is listed under Exhibit A.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This project is funded by proceeds of Surtax Funding allocated as part of Neighborhood Infrastructure Improvements (Project No. 2000000535) in the FY 2019-20 Adopted Multi-Year Capital Plan, the project is also included in the FY 2020-21 Proposed Budget. This program is part of the original Exhibit 1 to the Peoples' Transportation Plan as approved by voters. Work orders associated with this project will be issued when written approval is received from a Commission District office for the use of District PTP allocation as approved by Resolution No. R-507-04, adopted April 27, 2004 approving the amendment to the Neighborhood Improvements section of the People's Transportation Plan to include roadway signage, roadway lighting, pavement markings and traffic calming. There is no additional fiscal impact to operations or maintenance.

Track Record/Monitor

Florida Engineering and Development Corp. has performed work for DTPW at a satisfactory level. The Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database lists 3 performance evaluations with an average overall performance rating of 2.7 (satisfactory Performance) out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) ratings. This and other information is available through the Internal

Services Department (ISD). The Small Business Development Division (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this contractor. This information is available through SBD's Business Development Reports.

The project will be assigned to Joaquin Rabassa, P.E., Project Coordinator in DTPW for the day-to-day responsibilities.

Background

This contract provides DTPW a means of quickly responding to critical construction and repair needs via a competitively bid contract. The work on this contract is initiated via work order on an as-needed basis to address these needs. Within the contract, an estimated quantity is provided for bidding purposes as plan details are not available at the time of the bid.

This contract was originally procured through the MCC Program as noted in Exhibit A. DTPW forwarded a Request for Price Quotation for the projects in Exhibit A to the attached resolution, by way of e-mail transmission, to a pool of firms that had registered with ISD for each respective trade. Additionally, DTPW advertised the project in the Daily Business Review and all solicitations were available online through the County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The projects' award evaluation was based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and due diligence was conducted in accordance with ISD's Procurement Guidelines to determine Contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status with the Florida Department of State's Division of Corporations and reviewing of performance or compliance issues. A copy of all bids, and the bid tabulation for the project is available by contacting the Chief of the Capital Improvements Division of DTPW.

This item seeks authority to utilize Charter County Surtax Funds of up to \$945,000 to fund the projects listed in Exhibit B utilizing this contract. Consistent with Florida Statute 212.055, and section 29-124 and 2-1421 of the County Code, Surtax funds will be used for projects included in the Five Year PTP Implementation Plan. The administration has worked closely with District Commissioners and the Executive Director of the CITT to identify project which will improve mobility in neighborhoods.

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Background: On February 27, 2020, DTPW forwarded an RPQ for Intersection Improvements, utilizing the MCC 7360 Plan – CICC 7360-0/08 Contract, to a list of 77 pre-qualified firms. On April 1, 2020, five firms submitted bids.

Florida Engineering and Development, Corp. proffered the lowest responsive and responsible base bid of \$2,178,185.65, 8 percent below the County's cost estimate. The second lowest bidder, H & R Paving, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$2,407,664.12; 1 percent above the County's cost estimate. The third lowest bidder, Maggolo, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$2,665,813.50; 11 percent above the County's cost estimate. The fourth lowest bidder, Roadway Construction LLC., proffered a base bid of \$2,840,926.50; 19 percent above the County's cost estimate. The fifth lowest bidder, The Stout Group, LLC., proffered a base bid of \$3,022,497.00; 27 percent above the County's cost estimate. Based on the results of the solicitation, DTPW issued a recommendation for award on April 21, 2020 for RPQ No. 20200031 to Florida Engineering and Development, Corp.
