Subject: Resolution Approving Recommendation for Award of a Miscellaneous Construction Contract 7040 Plan – Request for Price Quotation Number: 404328 for Metromover Government Center Substation to College North Substation Cable Replacement Project to Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. in the Amount of \$770,000 and Authorizing the Use of People's Transportation Plan Bond Program Funds For Such Purposes

Recommendation

This Recommendation for Award of a *Miscellaneous Construction Contract (MCC) 7040 Plan – Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) Number: 404328 for Metromover Government Center Substation to College North Substation Cable Replacement project* to Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. (Contractor) in the amount of \$770,000 and a contract term of 182 calendar days, has been prepared by the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) pursuant to Section 2-8.2.7.01 of the Code of Miami-Dade County (Code).

This recommendation for award will provide for replacement of existing medium voltage cables that are used as a distribution line between the Government Center and College North stations. The distribution system is a 13.2 kV, three phase system. The Contractor will furnish all labor, permits, cables, cable termination materials and test equipment for the removal of the existing cables; furnish and install 15 kV cables; and conduct electrical testing of cables for each of the three phases.

This contract award recommendation is placed for Board review pursuant to the Code Section 29-124(f). This contract award recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, a request for withdrawal of this item will be submitted.

Scope

The scope of this item is countywide in nature as it benefits the users of the Metromover system. The Project extends from the Government Center Station to the College North Station in Downtown Miami. The Metromover system traverses County Commission Districts 3 and 5 represented by Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson and Commissioner Eileen Higgins, respectively.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact for the contract is \$770,000, which includes a contingency allowance amount of \$70,000 for any unforeseen work. This project is included in the FY 2019-20 Adopted Budget and Multi-Year Capital Plan and FY 2020-21 Proposed Budget. The funding source is People's

Transportation Plan Bond Program Funds. Throughout the life of the asset, there are no anticipated costs on operations and maintenance costs as this is a repair project.

Delegation of Authority

The authority of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute and implement this contract consistent with those authorities granted under the Code. No further delegation is necessary for this contract.

Background

The existing cable equipment was installed in 1985 as part of the initial construction of the Metromover system and has exceeded its useful life. The cable equipment consists of primary and secondary cables, the latter of which serve as redundant cables that provide power to the Omni extension. DTPW experienced a minimal service disruption due to a failure of the primary cables, the cause of which was degradation of the insulation and vibrations in the cable system. DTPW was able to transfer the load from the primary cables to the redundant cables. As a result, the Omni extension of the Metromover now has no redundant cables to transfer the load if there is another power failure. If the redundant cables currently supplying the power fail, it will result in a service shut down to the Omni extension. Therefore, construction services are required to replace the primary cables to restore power to these cables and resume use of the secondary cables as redundant cables for the equipment. RPQ No. 404328 is funded from the Metromover Comprehensive Wayside System Overhaul Project, which the Board approved as an addition to the PTP's Five-Year Implementation Plan on March 6, 2018, following a favorable recommendation by the CITT.

On January 8, 2020, DTPW contacted 63 contractors through the County's MCC 7040 Plan for construction services. A mandatory pre-bid conference and site visit were held on January 17, 2020, with attendance from four prospective bidders. DTPW received two bids in response to the solicitation on February 12, 2020. The base bid amounts ranged between \$700,000 and \$759,000 (excluding the allowance account). The Certificates of Assurance for the two bidders were forwarded to the Division of Small Business Development (SBD) and on March 5, 2020, both firms were found to be in compliance with the Small Business Enterprise-Construction (SBE-CON) requirements established for the project. The lowest bid price, submitted by Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. is 22.99% below DTPW's in-house cost estimate of \$909,000.

In addition to pricing, Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc.'s bid was reviewed based on its licensing, past experience and ability to perform services of similar scope, as described in the contract documents. On March 31, 2020, DTPW held a bid clarification meeting with Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. to review the project's scope of services and discuss the firm's bid price. DTPW staff reviewed Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc.'s supporting documentation and confirmed the firm's ability to perform the project's scope of services within the contract duration. On April 1, 2020, Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. provided a bid commitment letter, confirming its ability to perform the scope of services, inclusive of all addendums, for the price provided in its bid. As such, Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc.'s bid was determined by DTPW staff to be fair, reasonable and responsible. As part of the award process, DTPW staff compiled information regarding Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc.'s past experience with the County. Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. has 26 evaluations in the Capital Improvements Information System with an average rating of 3.8 points out

of a possible 4.0 points. Therefore, DTPW recommends that this contract be awarded to Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc.

The SBD Compliance Report Database reflects that Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. has no record of open or closed small business, wage and/or workforce violations within the last three years. The project has been assigned as a 100 percent SBE Level 3 Set Aside and a Community Workforce Program goal of 10 percent. According to the Firm History Report provided by SBD, within the last three years, Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. has held six contracts through the MCC 7040 Plan, with a total value of \$45,489.85 and no change orders.

The Project complies with all applicable federal, state and local regulations including Applicable Wages pursuant to Resolution No. R-54-10. With Board approval, is it anticipated that the Notice to Proceed to Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc. will be issued within 30 days of Board approval. The contractor will self-perform the scope of services; therefore, no subcontractors were identified.

Track Record/Monitor

Leticia Smith of DTPW is the Chief of Contract Services. The County is supervising, monitoring and inspecting all aspects of the Project's implementation, deployment and administration. Oscar Pineda, Chief Supervisor of Metromover Maintenance of DTPW is responsible for this Project.

Due Diligence

Due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines to determine contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status. The lists that were referenced include: SunBiz, convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, federal excluded parties, Duns and Bradstreet, and SBD's compliance report. There were no adverse findings related to contractor responsibility. This information is being provided pursuant to Resolution No. R-187-12.

Accura Electrical Contractor, Inc.'s safety records for the last three years were also considered. Copies of its Occupational Safety & Health Form 300 – Log of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses and inspection data are on file with DTPW's Office of Safety and Security and are available upon request. This information is being provided pursuant to Resolution No. R-1181-18.
