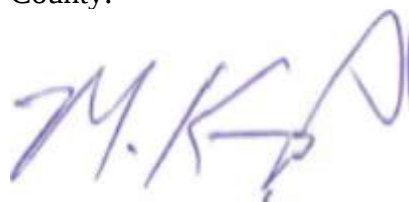

The proposed ordinance amends section 2-1445 of the Code providing that the Dr. Antonio Jorge Social and Economic Development Council shall be under the purview of the Board of County Commissioners rather than the Mayor, and directing the Mayor to amend the Fiscal Year 2020- 2021 budget to include staff support for the SEDC in the budget and table of organization of a certain office of the Board of County Commissioners

The proposed amendment will move the SEDC under the supervision of the Board of County Commissioners, specifically under the Office of Community Advocacy. This will allow the Board of County Commissioners to direct policies for social and economic development within Miami-Dade County.

ORDINANCE NO. 21-9

ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DR. ANTONIO JORGE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (“SEDC”); AMENDING SECTION 2-1445 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING THAT THE SEDC SHALL BE UNDER THE PURVIEW OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RATHER THAN THE MAYOR; DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 BUDGET TO INCLUDE STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE SEDC IN THE BUDGET AND TABLE OF ORGANIZATION OF A CERTAIN OFFICE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in 2002, this Board created and established the Dr. Antonio Jorge Social and Economic Development Council (“SEDC”) to address, among other things, the socioeconomic impacts of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the SEDC is charged with recommending to this Board and the Mayor appropriate policies and measures to reactivate the economy of Miami-Dade County (the “County”), with special attention to the needs of low-income segments of the population; and

WHEREAS, the SEDC also coordinates the formulation and implementation of long-term strategies to increase the per-capita income of the general population, diversify the local economy, and substantially reduce the prevailing rates of poverty in the County; and

WHEREAS, currently, the Administration provides the SEDC with departmental staff support and the resources necessary to enable the SEDC to carry out its duties and functions through the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources; and

WHEREAS, due to the economic effects of the coronavirus disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) pandemic, it is in the best interests of the County for this Board to direct policies for social and economic development; and

WHEREAS, accordingly, this Board wishes to place the SEDC under the purview of this Board rather than the Mayor,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 2-1445 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:¹

Sec. 2-1445. Staff Support.

>>(a)<< The ~~[[County—Manager]]~~ >>Board of County Commissioners, Office of Community Advocacy,<< shall provide adequate ~~[[departmental]]~~ staff support and access to the necessary resources to enable the Council to carry out its duties, functions and responsibilities.

Section 2. The Board directs the County Mayor to amend the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 budget to include the SEDC, inclusive of all of its staff support, programs, and subcommittees, within the budget and table of organization for the Board of County Commissioners, Office of Community Advocacy.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

¹ Words stricken through and/or [[double bracketed]] shall be deleted. Words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< constitute the amendment proposed. Remaining provisions are now in effect and remain unchanged.

Section 4. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that section 1 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
