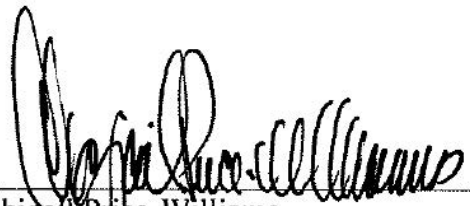

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE JUNE 19, 2020 “JUNETEENTH UNITY PEACEFUL PROTEST” SPONSORED BY THE FAITH IN FLORIDA, INC. IN AN AMOUNT OF \$1,800.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 3 FY 2019-20 IN-KIND RESERVE

WHEREAS, the Faith in Florida, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the June 19, 2020 “Juneteenth Unity Peaceful Protest” in an amount of \$1,800.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the Faith in Florida, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the “Juneteenth Unity Peaceful Protest” is a community march to Partners Park, which includes a memorial service to mourn and honor the lives lost due to racial injustice; and

WHEREAS, the “Juneteenth Unity Peaceful Protest” brings the community together to promote justice for all; and

WHEREAS, the “Juneteenth Unity Peaceful Protest” is a special event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$1,800.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 3 FY 2019-20 In-Kind Reserve,
