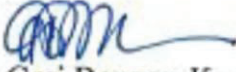

RESOLUTION NO. R-1214-20

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXAMINE THE
FEASIBILITY OF INSTALLING LICENSE PLATE READERS
AT COUNTY REGIONAL PARKS, AND REQUIRING A
REPORT

WHEREAS, there are 13 regional parks in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, millions of visitors visit the regional parks every year; and

WHEREAS, license plates readers allow law enforcement to know when a vehicle enters
a park and when it leaves; and

WHEREAS, license plate readers use high-speed cameras and computer software to
capture license plate images and convert the images into data that can be compared with law
enforcement databases; and

WHEREAS, license plate readers could work as a deterrent to crime within the regional
parks and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, license plate readers are successfully used by several local municipalities
including Doral and Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, the safety of our communities and especially the safety of park users is of
paramount concern to this Board,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

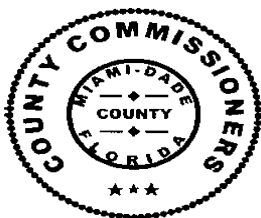
Section 1. Directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to examine the
feasibility of installing license plate readers at County regional parks.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to provide a report to the Board regarding the directive set forth in Section 1 of this resolution within 60 days of the date of this resolution, and to place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65. The report shall include the projected cost of installation, operation, and maintenance of the license plate readers.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
