RESOLUTION NO. R-1227-20

RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE AN ORAL
REPORT TO THE PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL
AFFAIRS COMMITTEE REGARDING CERTAIN
HAPPENINGS AT COUNTY PARKS

WHEREAS, under the Home Rule Amendment and Charter (the "Charter"), the Board of County Commissioners (the "Commission") is the legislative and governing body of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is responsible for the management of all administrative departments and for carrying out policies adopted by the Commission; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with the Charter, all County policy decisions are within the purview of the Commission and the Mayor is responsible for the County's operations in accordance with the policies adopted by the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs Committee is the committee designated to park policy in the County; and

WHEREAS, in order to make the most informed policy decisions as related to parks, this Board desires to receive the most up-to-date information regarding the parks throughout the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

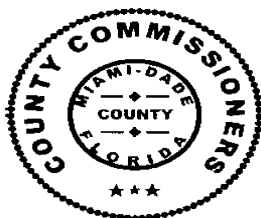
Section 1. The foregoing recitals are approved and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The County Mayor or the Mayor’s designee shall provide an oral report as needed at the monthly Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs Committee, or at any successor committee with jurisdiction over County parks, regarding the following; (i) significant, adverse environmental findings at any County park, including contamination; (ii) any anticipated or actual media coverage regarding County parks; (iii) high-profile projects and including construction and renovation projects at County parks that are valued over \$200,000.00; and (iv) any material changes to park services, including but not limited to, the removal or alteration to the organization or aesthetics of recreational facilities and changes in park programming offerings, scope and hours.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
