Subject: Recommendation to Reject All Proposals: Endpoint Security Enterprise Solution

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the rejection of all proposals received under *Request for Proposals No. RFP-01282, Endpoint Security Enterprise Solution*, for the Information Technology Department (ITD).

In late 2019, ITD conducted a review of best practices for cyber security in preparation for the upcoming Super Bowl LIV. As part of this review, an uptick in cyber attacks on public entities was identified. As a result, under Resolution No. R-1300-19, an emergency contract was established with FireEye Inc. to obtain managed cyber security services to proactively reinforce the County's security portfolio. Managed cyber security services provide a holistic approach to enterprise cyber security and monitoring, including analytics, threat intelligence and detection, as well as protection and containment for the County's hardware and software infrastructure. Following the emergency contract, Contract No. 190000001531 was established under Resolution No. R-1302-19 for a three-year term to allow the County to continue to obtain managed cyber security services from FireEye, Inc.

Prior to establishing Contract No. 190000001531, the County had issued a competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) No. RFP-01282 to select an Endpoint Security Enterprise Solution to provide cyber security for devices that reside on the County's network. Endpoint security is one component of managed cyber security services. As a result of the updated approach to cyber security which was established in preparation for Super Bowl LIV, a standalone contract for an endpoint security solution is no longer needed and rejection of all proposals is recommended.

Due to the critical nature of cyber security, as detailed in Resolution No. R-1302-19, ITD will conduct a thorough review of the cyber security industry, including threats, standards, best practices, current requirements, and providers in the industry during the term of Contract No. 190000001531 in order to develop a comprehensive RFP to select a provider for managed cyber security services for the future. This RFP will include, but will not be limited to endpoint security. It is anticipated that this RFP will be presented to the Board in 2022.

Scope

The scope of this item is countywide in nature.

There is no fiscal impact for the rejection of proposals.

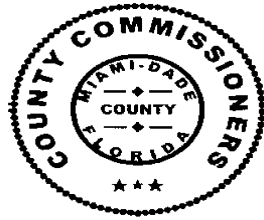
WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,
