R-1158-20, THE COUNTY SHALL AFFORD ANY MUNICIPALITIES THAT HAVE RECEIVED FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY THROUGH THE 2020 CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT) CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND FOR CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) PANDEMIC RESPONSE, AS MUCH TIME AS NECESSARY TO EXPEND SUCH FUNDS BEFORE THE DECEMBER 30, 2020 DEADLINE IMPOSED BY THE CARES ACT

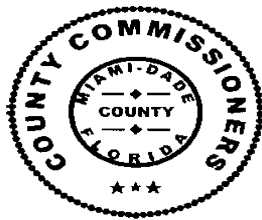
WHEREAS, at the December 1, 2020 special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, a motion was made setting County policy that, notwithstanding the provisions of Resolution No. R-1158-20, the County shall afford any municipalities that have received funds from the County made available through the 2020 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) Coronavirus Relief Fund for coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic response, as much time as necessary to expend such funds before the December 30, 2020 deadline imposed by the CARES Act,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board sets County policy that, notwithstanding the provisions of Resolution No. R-1158-20, the County shall afford any municipalities that have received funds from the County made available through the CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Fund for COVID-19 pandemic response, as much time as necessary to expend such funds before the December 30, 2020 deadline imposed by the CARES Act.
