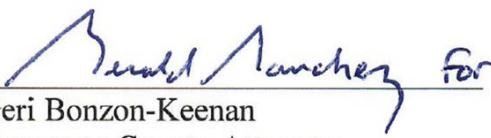

RESOLUTION NO. R-1235-20

**RESOLUTION URGING THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) TO REIMBURSE THE
COUNTY FOR PROVISION OF FOOD TO ELDERLY COUNTY
RESIDENTS**

WHEREAS, at the December 7, 2020 Special Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, a motion was adopted (1) urging the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to authorize reimbursements for the County's provision of food to elderly residents in prospective 90-day periods after December 31, 2020; (2) directing the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the members of the Miami-Dade County Federal Legislative Delegation; and (3) directing the County's federal lobbyists to advocate for the actions set forth in (1) above, and authorizing and directing the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2020 Federal Legislative Package to include this item and to include this item in the 2021 Federal Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges FEMA to authorize reimbursements for the County's provision of food to elderly residents in prospective 90-day periods after December 31, 2020.

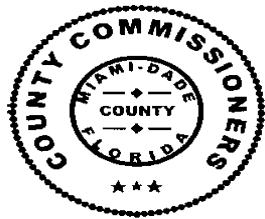
Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the members of the Miami-Dade County Federal Legislative Delegation.

Section 3. Directs the County's federal lobbyists to advocate for the actions set forth in section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2020 Federal Legislative Package to include this item and to include this item in the 2021 Federal Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Acting Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
