RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW 89TH PLACE BETWEEN SW 48TH STREET AND SW 56TH STREET (MILLER DRIVE) AS “ROBERTO JOEL ABRAHANTE PLACE”

**WHEREAS**, Roberto Joel Abrahante was born in 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, Roberto Joel Abrahante started his childhood in the foster care system; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2005, Roberto Joel Abrahante found stability and a permanent family when he and his brother were adopted; and

**WHEREAS**, Roberto Joel Abrahante was actively involved at his high school, Southwest Miami Senior High, where he was a member of the junior varsity and varsity basketball team for four years; and

**WHEREAS**, Roberto Joel Abrahante was a beloved member of the Southwest Miami Senior High community where he was elected “Mr. Freshman” and “Mr. Sophomore” by his peers; and

**WHEREAS**, Roberto Joel Abrahante spent countless hours at Southwest Miami Senior High, particularly at the school’s gymnasium and basketball courts located near the southwest corner of 89th Place; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 20, 2019, Roberto Joel Abrahante tragically passed away in a fatal traffic accident at age 18; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to recognize the connection that Roberto Joel Abrahante had with Southwest Miami Senior High by codesignating that portion of SW 89th Place between SW 48th Street and SW 56th Street (Miller Drive) as “Roberto Joel Abrahante Place”; and

**WHEREAS**, that portion of SW 89th Place between SW 48th Street and SW 56th Street (Miller Drive) is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of SW 89th Place between SW 48th Street and SW 56th Street (Miller Drive) as “Roberto Abrahante Place”.

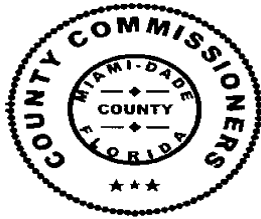
**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
