RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO COLLABORATE WITH SUNSHINE HEALTH OR ANY OTHER ENTITY PARTICIPATING IN CELEBRATION OF THE HANDS EVENT DURING CHILDREN'S WEEK FLORIDA; AND, PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. R-240-16, APPROVING DISPLAYS THAT ARE IN RECOGNITION OF CELEBRATION OF THE HANDS IN THE STEPHEN P. CLARK CENTER SECURED LOBBY AREA

WHEREAS, Children's Week Florida is an annual event held in the Florida Capitol each year to celebrate children and families and to highlight the critical issues they face; and

WHEREAS, this event began over 25 years ago and expanded over time from a single day event to a full week of advocacy activities and events; and

WHEREAS, in prior years, thousands of people have gathered at the Florida Capitol for Children's Week Florida; and

WHEREAS, as part of Children's Week, each year hand artwork collected from early learning programs and schools across the state and decorated by young children, teachers, and families, are hung throughout the Capitol Rotunda; and

WHEREAS, this display, known as Celebration of the Hands, serves as a reminder to representatives, senators, advocates, and visitors of the Capitol of the children and youth in Florida who are impacted by policy decisions made by the Florida Legislature; and

WHEREAS, this year Children's Week Florida will be observed April 5 through 9, 2021; and

WHEREAS, due to the coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic and constraints on individuals congregating in the Capitol, this year local partners will help display the hand art for Celebration of the Hands during Children’s Week Florida; and

WHEREAS, Sunshine Health is the organizing partner for this event and is working with local partners to exhibit such displays; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to participate in Celebration of the Hands by displaying hand art in the Stephen P. Clark center as this will serve as a reminder to this Board of the children impacted by its policy decisions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Board directs that the County Mayor or the County Mayor’s designee collaborate with Sunshine Health or any other entity participating in Celebration of the Hands event during Children’s Week Florida and, as part of Celebration of the Hands, approves, in accordance with Resolution No. R-240-16, exhibits for display in the secured area of the Stephen P. Clark Center lobby.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
