Subject: Recommendation for Approval to Reject Dockside Container Handling Cranes for PortMiami

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the rejection of all proposals received for *Solicitation No. RFP 00679, Dockside Container Handling Cranes*, for PortMiami.

On January 31, 2018, a Request for Proposals was issued under full and open competition for the design, fabrication, erection, painting, transportation, installation, testing and commission of three additional rail-mounted gantry container cranes; four spreaders; and two overheight adaptors and spare parts. The solicitation required that the Contractor install and assemble the cranes at the Lummus Island Container Cranes facility within 558 calendar days from the date of Notice-to-Proceed. In addition, the solicitation also included the option to purchase two additional cranes, in accordance with the requirements and technical specifications.

Three proposals from Bedeschi American Inc., Konecranes, and Shanghai Zhenhua Heavy Industries Co. LTD, and one no bid, were received. The Competitive Selection Committee scored and ranked the firms, and recommended negotiations with the highest-ranked proposer, Shanghai Zhenhua Heavy Industries Co., Ltd. Award of this solicitation was placed on hold in December 2019.

As the proposals are now over three years old, PortMiami is reviewing the specifications to ensure that the County will receive the latest technology. Therefore, it is recommended that these proposals be rejected. Upon approval of this rejection, a new Request for Proposals will be advertised.

Scope

The PortMiami is located in District 5, which is represented by Commissioner Eileen Higgins. However, the impact of this item is countywide, as PortMiami is a regional asset.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

There is no fiscal impact to the County with the rejection of all proposals.

Track Record/Monitor

Basia M. Pruna, CPPB, of the Internal Services Department is the Assistant Division Director.

Applicable Ordinances and Contract Measures

- The two percent User Access Program provision would have applied where permitted by the funding source.

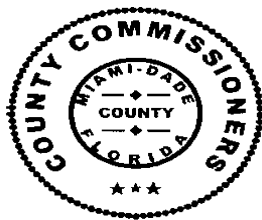
WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,
