RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-258-21

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF
HOMESTEAD AVENUE FROM BANYAN STREET TO SW
184TH STREET AS “LEE C. JAY AVENUE”

WHEREAS, Lee C. Jay (“Mr. Jay”), after serving in the U.S. Navy, returned to Florida and founded several funeral homes in the South Florida area, culminating in the establishment of Jay Funeral Home in Perrine in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jay was well-known in the community for his dignity, integrity, and ability to comfort people during their times of bereavement; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jay left an undeniable impact on the lives of those in our community both for his 40 years of service at Jay Funeral Home and the empathy he showed to those who came to know him in times of need; and

WHEREAS, Although Mr. Jay passed away on August 13, 2019, his impact on the community will last for many generations; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Mr. Jay and his contributions to our community by codesignating that portion of Homestead Avenue from Banyan Street to SW 184th Street as “Lee C. Jay Avenue”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Homestead Avenue from Banyan Street to SW 184th Street is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 9,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

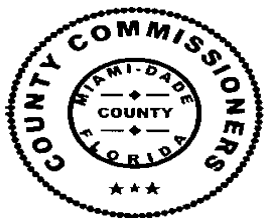
Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of Homestead Avenue from Banyan Street to SW 184th Street as “Lee C. Jay Avenue”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
