RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF SOUTH MIAMI'S
CODESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF SW 64TH COURT
FROM SW 70TH STREET TO MANOR LANE AS "BICYCLE
BOB WELSH COURT"

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2021, the City of South Miami's Mayor and City Commission passed Resolution No. 024-21-15644, which codesignated a portion of SW 64th Court from SW 70th Street to Manor Lane as "Bicycle Bob Welsh Court"; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution No. 024-21-15644 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2021, South Miami Vice Mayor Robert "Bicycle Bob" Welsh, a community advocate, died at age 67 after battling skin cancer and related health problems; and

WHEREAS, Welsh acquired his nickname as a result of his habit of biking throughout South Miami and greeting residents; and

WHEREAS, he was born and raised in the South Miami area and attended Coral Gables Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, Welsh was first elected to the South Miami Commission; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, he was elected to his second four-year term; and

WHEREAS, Welsh was known throughout the community for his efforts to plant thousands of trees throughout South Miami; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SW 64th Court from SW 70th Street to Manor Lane is a city road located in the City of South Miami; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 7; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor South Miami Vice Mayor Robert “Bicycle Bob” Welsh by approving the City of South Miami’s codesignation of that portion of SW 64th Court from SW 70th Street to Manor Lane as “Bicycle Bob Welsh Court”,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

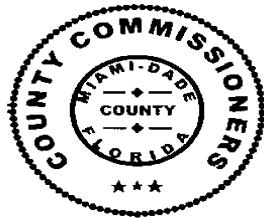
Section 1. Approves the City of South Miami’s codesignation of that portion of SW 64th Court from SW 70th Street to Manor Lane as “Bicycle Bob Welsh Court”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Mayor and City Commission of the City of South Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, and the City of South Miami Police Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins** and upon being put to a vote the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 024-21-15644

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Commission of the City of South Miami, to honor Vice Mayor Robert "Bob" Welsh, by naming SW 64th Court from 70th Street to Manor Lane as "Bicycle Bob Welsh Court."

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission desire to name SW 64th Court from 70th Street to Manor Lane as "Bicycle Bob Welsh Court"; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Commission of the City of South Miami to honor the memory of Vice Mayor Bob Welsh, a longtime resident, dedicated civil servant and an activist that worked tirelessly to improve our environment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and they are incorporated into this resolution by reference as if set forth in full herein.

Section 2: SW 64th Court from SW 70th Street to Manor Lane shall be known as "Bicycle Bob Welsh Court." Signs shall be made and installed at the present street location as soon as authorized by Miami Dade County.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be provided to the US Postal Service and to the appropriate agencies, upon approval by Miami-Dade County of the street naming.

Section 4: Corrections. Conforming language or technical scrivener-type corrections may be made by the City Attorney for any conforming amendments to be incorporated into the final resolution for signature.

Section 5: Severability. If any section clause, sentence, or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

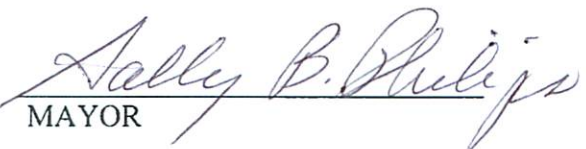
Section 6: Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by vote of the City Commission.
