Subject: Request to Reject all Proposals for Design-Build Services for Project Entitled People’s Transportation Plan (PTP) Roadway Improvements to NE 2nd Avenue from NE 20th Street to NE 36th Street (Project No: DB19-DTPW-03; Contract No: 20190256)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the rejection of all proposals received for Solicitation No. DB19-DTPW-03 Design-Build Services for People’s Transportation Plan (PTP) Roadway Improvements to NE 2nd Avenue from NE 20th Street to NE 36th Street (DTPW Project No. 20190256).

On July 7, 2020, a Request for Design-Build Services (RDBS) was advertised under full and open competition. On August 14, 2020, three (3) proposals were received through the online portal, Bid Sync, and all were deemed qualified and advanced to Step 2 of the process. After conclusion of the Alternate Technical Concept (ATC) process, the three firms submitted technical and price proposals through BidSync on December 23, 2020.

In general, a Design Build proposer is allowed to propose modifications to a Concept Plan provided in the Design Criteria Package (DCP) if the Concept Plan is a “Reference” file. Modification to any of the “Attachments” in the DCP however, requires an approved ATC from DTPW prior to submission of proposals. The DCP for this project inadvertently did not identify the Concept Plans as either “Attachments” or “Reference Files.” As a result, one proposer took exceptions in its technical proposal without knowing that approval was required prior to submission. The other two proposers requested approval through the ATC process. Due to this ambiguity and to ensure a level playing field for all proposers, rejection is recommended for this project.

The staff has amended future and ongoing DCPs to ensure that each document is properly identified as either an “Attachment” or “Reference” file. The project will be readvertised under a different project number. No changes will be performed to the scope of work, which is included below.

Delegation of Authority

The authority of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute this rejection of proposals is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County. No additional delegation of authority is being requested.

Scope

The work includes but is not limited to the following: Furnishing all professional services, supervision, labor, materials, equipment, tools and performing all operations required to construct the work in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The work includes all design and construction services necessary to perform roadway reconstruction, new stormwater system, sidewalks, curb and gutters, pavement markings, signage, signalization, decorative lighting, and landscaping. Work also includes all design and construction services necessary to install 4600 linear feet of 16-inch ductile iron pipe (DIP) water main and 1500 linear feet of 12-inch DIP water main and all appurtenances.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

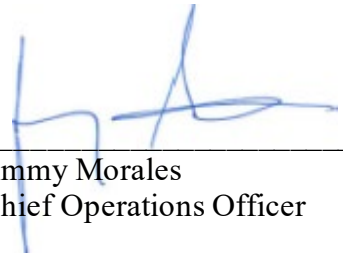
There is no fiscal impact to the County with the rejection of proposals.

Background

NE 2nd Avenue is an important North-South transportation corridor within the City of Miami. This corridor and the adjacent areas have experienced significant growth over the past few years. This is expected to continue as large commercial and residential projects are built and occupied. As such, providing for mobility along this corridor at an acceptable level is critical to the surrounding areas. The typical section selection was based on a traffic study completed by the City of Miami in 2015 and recommendations from the DTPW’s Traffic Engineering Division. From the study, an alternative was selected that provides for two travel lanes and one bicycle lane in each direction. This alternative will maintain the overall Level of Service (LOS) at C.

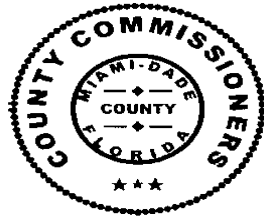
WHERE AS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,
