WHEREAS, the Air & Sea Show will be free to the public, with the opportunity to upgrade one’s experience with VIP tickets; and

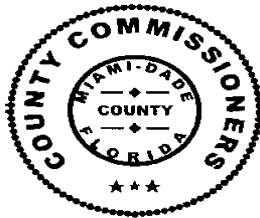
