RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE A WRITTEN
REPORT REGARDING THE AVAILABILITY OF POOLS AND
AQUATIC CENTERS

WHEREAS, this Board is committed to enhancing the quality of life of residents and visitors to the County through the promotion of healthy recreational activities at our parks; and

WHEREAS, pools and aquatic centers are an important component of recreation in the County; and

WHEREAS, swimming safety is incredibly important to coastal communities like Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires that all residents of the County have access to pools and aquatic centers; and

WHEREAS, this Board seeks information regarding pools, aquatic centers, and programming at County parks,

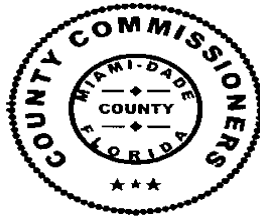
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide a report to this Board within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution, and to place the completed report on an agenda of this Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65. The report shall include at minimum: (i) a list, divided by County Commission district, of the County-operated pools and aquatic centers in the County; (ii) the maximum occupancy levels at County pools and aquatic centers; (iii) historical data on County

pool and aquatic center usage; and (iv) information regarding any County pool or aquatic center closures due to COVID-19 or maintenance issues; and (v) what programming is provided by either the County or outside vendors at County pools and aquatic centers, and the cost charged to residents for such programming; (vi) the cost of admittance to County pools and aquatic centers.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote the vote was as follows:
