RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-755-21

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO TAKE ANY AND ALL
ACTIONS TO ENABLE AND ENCOURAGE MIAMI-DADE
COUNTY DEPARTMENTS AND EMPLOYEES TO
PARTICIPATE IN THE MIAMI ALZHEIMER'S WALK ON
NOVEMBER 20, 2021

WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause of death in the United States
and the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, between 2000 and 2019, deaths from Alzheimer's disease have increased
145 percent; and

WHEREAS, more than 6 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's disease and that
number is projected to rise to nearly 14 million by 2050; and

WHEREAS, in Florida, 1 in every 38 people of all ages has Alzheimer's disease and at
least 580,000 individuals age 65 or older are living with Alzheimer's disease; and

WHEREAS, by 2025, the number of individuals in the State of Florida age 65 and older
with Alzheimer's dementia is estimated to increase by 28.6 percent reaching 720,000; and

WHEREAS, at present, there is no cure for Alzheimer's disease; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast Florida Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association is a not-for-
profit 501(c)(3) organization committed to eliminating Alzheimer's disease, and all other
dementia, through the advancement of research; to provide care and support to those affected; and
to reduce the risk of dementia through the promotion of brain health; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast Florida Chapter of the Alzheimer’s Association hosts an annual Alzheimer’s Walk in an effort to raise funds and awareness for a breakthrough in the fight against Alzheimer’s and all other dementia; and

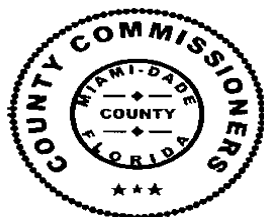
WHEREAS, this Board supports Alzheimer’s disease research and education and the efforts of the Southeast Florida Chapter of the Alzheimer’s Association,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to take any and all actions to enable and encourage Miami-Dade County departments and employees to participate in the Miami Alzheimer’s Walk on November 20, 2021.
