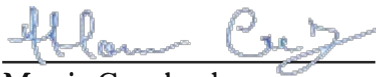

The proposed ordinance waives the age requirement of section 2-2381 of the Code of Miami-Dade County as to Nercy Radcliffe. If adopted, the ordinance waives the age requirement of section 2-2381 and appoints Nercy Radcliffe to serve as a member of the Miami-Dade County Elder Affairs Advisory Board for a term of four years in accordance with section 2-2381 of the Code or as otherwise set forth in section 2-11.38.2 of the Code.

The proposed ordinance is expected to benefit Miami-Dade County older adults and the community at large, as Nercy Radcliffe brings extensive experience as a healthcare leader in Miami-Dade County with a focus on people as they age. As a long-standing member of the community, Nercy Radcliffe’s membership in the Elder Affairs Advisory Board will allow her to provide expertise and insights on issues impacting the quality of life for the elderly residents of Miami-Dade County.

ORDINANCE NO. 21-116

ORDINANCE WAIVING THE AGE REQUIREMENT OF SECTION 2-2381 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA AS TO NERCY RADCLIFFE TO ALLOW NERCY RADCLIFFE TO SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ELDER AFFAIRS ADVISORY BOARD; APPOINTING NERCY RADCLIFFE TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ELDER AFFAIRS ADVISORY BOARD; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, EXCLUSION FROM THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, this Board has a longstanding interest in and concern for the senior population in Miami-Dade County, which is demonstrated by its funding of services, programming, and facilities for elderly persons; and

WHEREAS, such interest and concern were exemplified through the creation of the Miami-Dade County Elder Affairs Advisory Board (“Elder Affairs Advisory Board”); and

WHEREAS, specifically, on May 1, 2018, this Board adopted Ordinance No. 18-49 and created the Elder Affairs Advisory Board, which is codified in article CLX of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida (“Code”); and

WHEREAS, the Elder Affairs Advisory Board is charged with:

1. advising this Board, the Chairperson of the Board, and the Mayor on policy matters pertaining to the elderly community in Miami-Dade County, as may be requested;
2. advising the Board and Mayor on issues related to Miami-Dade County’s programming, public services, and facilities for elderly persons, including, but not limited to transportation/mobility services, health care services, and affordable housing;

3. serving as a liaison with the elderly community; and
4. recommending activities or programming that promote a healthy lifestyle and enhance quality of life for elderly persons; and

WHEREAS, this Board welcomes the advice of seniors with varied life experiences to inform future Board initiatives that could impact Miami-Dade County's elderly population; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 2-2381 of the Code, the minimum age for a person to be eligible to serve on the Elder Affairs Advisory Board is 55 years of age; and

WHEREAS, however, this Board recognizes that some individuals who have not yet reached the minimum age requirement could serve as valuable resources to and members of the Elder Affairs Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Nercy Radcliffe is one such individual; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Radcliffe is the president and administrator of Providence Healthcare Services, Inc., and has a background in business administration and management; and

WHEREAS, a copy of her resume is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to waive section 2-2381 of the Code to allow Nercy Radcliffe to serve on the Elder Affairs Advisory Board,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. This Board approves the foregoing whereas recitals.

Section 2. This Board waives the age requirement of section 2-2381 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida as to Nercy Radcliffe to allow Nercy Radcliffe to serve as a member of the Miami-Dade County Elder Affairs Advisory Board.

Section 3. This Board appoints Nercy Radcliffe to serve as a member of the Miami-Dade County Elder Affairs Advisory Board for a term of four years in accordance with section 2-2381 of the Code or as otherwise set forth in section 2-11.38.2 of the Code.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 5. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall be excluded from the Code of Miami-Dade County.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
