RESOLUTION NO. **R-848-21**

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXTEND THE SHORT-TERM FINANCIAL RELIEF FOR CERTAIN BUSINESS PARTNERS AT MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT FROM OCTOBER 1, 2021 TO NO LATER THAN THE APPROVAL OF THE LONG-TERM FINANCIAL RELIEF, OR IF NOT APPROVED, TWO WEEKS AFTER SUCH NON-APPROVAL

WHEREAS, at the September 1, 2021 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to extend the short-term financial relief for certain business partners at Miami International Airport, pursuant to Resolution No. R-753-21, from October 1, 2021 to no later than the approval of the long-term financial relief, or if not approved, two weeks after such non-approval,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to extend the short-term financial relief for certain business partners at Miami International Airport, pursuant to Resolution No. R-753-21, from October 1, 2021 to no later than the approval of the long-term financial relief, or if not approved, two weeks after such non-approval.

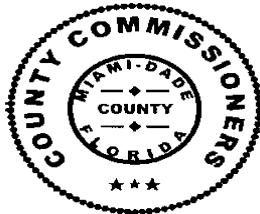
