RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A WRITTEN
REPORT TO THE BOARD OUTLINING UNSAFE
STRUCTURES ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES AND
DISCLOSING NUMBER OF OPEN UNSAFE STRUCTURES
CASES AND RELATED INFORMATION

WHEREAS, section 8-5 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida established the Unsafe Structures Board and Unsafe Structures Appeals Panel to hear appeals of the decisions of Building Officials declaring structures to be unsafe where there is a danger to the health and safety of the residents of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, both the Unsafe Structures Board and Unsafe Structures Appeal Panel have jurisdiction in both the incorporated and unincorporated areas of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, at the time of the Surfside collapse, there may have been 1,000 unsafe structures cases somewhere in the enforcement pipeline; and

WHEREAS, given the potentially high number of open unsafe structures cases and the tragic loss of life at Surfside, this Board believes it is imperative that the Board has a complete understanding of the unsafe structures enforcement processes and procedures, the number of open unsafe structures cases and other related information to ensure that the dangers caused by unsafe structures and buildings are remedied to protect the public,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as true and correct.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to prepare a written report outlining the unsafe structures enforcement procedures and disclosing the number of open enforcement cases before the Unsafe Structures Board and Unsafe Structures Appeals Panel. The report shall disclose ~~[[the number of open enforcement cases pending per municipality,]]~~¹ the number of open enforcement cases pending in unincorporated Miami-Dade County, the number of demolition orders issued by the Unsafe Structures Board and Unsafe Structures Appeals Panel during the last five years, the number of structures demolished per a demolition order during the last five years and the average length of time an enforcement proceeding takes before the Unsafe Structures Board and Unsafe Structures Appeals Panel. >>The report shall also include the number of open enforcement cases pending per municipality based upon information provided by municipalities in response to the County Mayor's or County Mayor's designee's requests.<< The report shall also identify issues and challenges the Unsafe Structures Board and Unsafe Structures Appeals Panel faces in moving enforcement proceedings to a conclusion that protects the public through the remediation, repair or demolition of the unsafe structure.

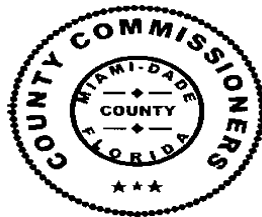
Section 3. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide this report to this Board within ~~[[45]]~~ >>95<< Days of the effective date of this resolution, and to place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.
