RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-1088-21

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW 132
AVENUE BETWEEN SW 42 STREET (BIRD ROAD) AND SW
56 STREET AS “JOSE MANUEL DORADO WAY”

WHEREAS, Jose Manuel Dorado, affectionately known as “Manolo,” was a man of great faith who devoted his life to serving God, charitable acts, and his family; and

WHEREAS, born in Havana, Cuba on May 28, 1939, to Manuel Dorado and Velia Portales, Mr. Dorado attended the La Salle School, which his father was also affiliated with; and

WHEREAS, in 1967, Mr. Dorado and his wife, Olga Dorado, emigrated to Miami in search of a better life; and

WHEREAS, from there, Mr. Dorado dedicated his life to helping those in need, especially children, just as his father had done in Cuba through his involvement with the La Salle School; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dorado went on to serve 25 years as a Board Member of De La Salle Asociación de Antiguos Alumnos (De La Salle Alumni Association) and a volunteer at the La Salle Educational Center in Homestead, where he worked tirelessly to help Mexican migrant families and children; and

WHEREAS, in 1991, Mr. Dorado helped open and manage an after-school care center and summer program in Naranja at no cost to Mexican migrant parents, which he remained affiliated with until May of 2018; and

WHEREAS, this center continues to serve the community under the management of the Archdiocese of Miami; and

WHEREAS, in 2003, Mr. Dorado began working with UMAEL-RELAL, an international group dedicated to providing support and religious outlets to Latino youth; and

WHEREAS, a great source of pride for Mr. Dorado was that, as part of his work with UMAEL-RELAL, he was able to help sponsor and raise funds for a group of Cuban adolescents to attend a Catholic retreat in Panama in January of 2019, which he attended as well; and

WHEREAS, throughout the years, Mr. Dorado has touched and improved the lives of countless families, often giving them hope when they needed it most; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dorado passed away at the age of 81 on April 10, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dorado is survived by his beloved wife, children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of Mr. Dorado and his contributions to the community, this Board would like to codesignate that portion of SW 132 Avenue between SW 42 Street (Bird Road) and SW 56 Street as “Jose Manuel Dorado Way”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SW 132 Avenue between SW 42 Street (Bird Road) and SW 56 Street is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County and County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

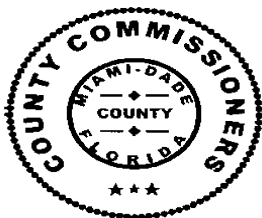
Section 1. Having considered the matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of SW 132 Avenue between SW 42 Street (Bird Road) and SW 56 Street as “Jose Manuel Dorado Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Kionne L. McGhee** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
