RESOLUTION HONORING FALLEN OFFICER YANDY
CHIRINO

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2021, 28-year-old Yandy Chirino, a four-year veteran of the Hollywood Police Department, was shot in the line of duty and died; and

WHEREAS, Yandy Chirino was born on March 14, 1993 in Havana, Cuba, emigrated to the United States as a child, and attended Miami Coral Park Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, Officer Chirino was remembered by friends and family for his love of life, his work ethic, his willingness to help others, and his positivity; and

WHEREAS, Officer Chirino died a hero serving and protecting the community in which he grew up; and

WHEREAS, Officer Chirino was mourned at his funeral by over 3,000 attendees, including dignitaries and scores of law enforcement officers, all of whom recognized the enormous bravery and sacrifice Officer Chirino displayed; and

WHEREAS, Officer Chirino's bravery and sacrifice must be honored and remembered; and

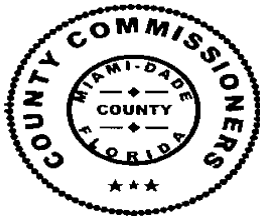
WHEREAS, this Board wishes to recognize and honor Officer Yandy Chirino, who made the ultimate sacrifice protecting his community and died a hero,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby recognizes and honors fallen Officer Yandy Chirino for his bravery and for making the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty.
