RESOLUTION HONORING THE WORK, ACHIEVEMENTS,
AND COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION OF
SUPERINTENDENT ALBERTO M. CARVALHO

WHEREAS, Alberto M. Carvalho was born in Portugal to a father who worked as a custodian and mother who worked as a seamstress and was one of six children and the only one to graduate high school; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Carvalho began his career in education as a physics, chemistry, and calculus teacher at Miami Jackson Senior High where he later became an assistant principal at the school. Mr. Carvalho also worked as principal, chief communications officer, a school district lobbyist, and assistant superintendent of Miami-Dade Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, Alberto M. Carvalho has served as Superintendent of Miami-Dade County Public Schools since September 2008; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade Public Schools is the nation's fourth largest school system; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Carvalho is a nationally recognized expert on education transformation, finance and leadership development; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure, Miami-Dade Public Schools has become one of the nation's highest-performing urban school systems; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Carvalho honors include Florida's 2014 Superintendent of the Year, the 2014 National Superintendent of the Year, the 2016 winner of the Harold W. McGraw Prize in Education, and the 2018 National Urban Superintendent of the Year; and

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2021, Mr. Carvalho announced his departure for Los Angeles as its new superintendent; and

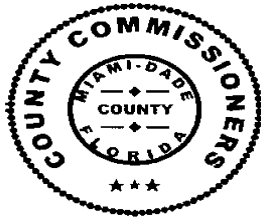
WHEREAS, this Board wishes to recognize all of the achievements of Alberto M. Carvalho and his commitment to education in Miami-Dade County,
