RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-155-22

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW
103RD AVENUE FROM HOWARD DRIVE TO SW 138TH
STREET AS “WILLIAM ALEXANDER WAY”

WHEREAS, William Alexander (“Alexander”), known affectionately as “the Captain” by those close to him, was a pilot for Eastern Airlines and a veteran of the Bay of Pigs invasion; and

WHEREAS, Alexander also served as the president of the Latin Chamber of Commerce of the United States, the largest Hispanic chamber of commerce in Florida, beginning in 2002; and

WHEREAS, Alexander, who called golf one of his greatest passions, created the Golf Tournament of the Americas hosted in the City of Doral; and

WHEREAS, Alexander left an undeniable impact on the lives of those in our community; and

WHEREAS, Although Alexander passed away at the age of 94 on May 16, 2017, his impact on the community will last for many generations; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Alexander and his contributions to our community by codesignating that portion of SW 103rd Avenue from Howard Drive to SW 138th Street as “William Alexander Way”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SW 103rd Avenue from Howard Drive to SW 138th Street is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

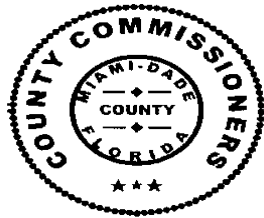
Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of SW 103rd Avenue from Howard Drive to SW 138th Street as “William Alexander Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Co-Prime Sponsors of the foregoing resolution are Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado and Commissioner Danielle Cohen Higgins, and the Co-Sponsor is Chairman Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner **Raquel A. Regalado** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Danielle Cohen Higgins** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
