RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI'S
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF NORTHWEST 3
STREET FROM NORTHWEST 12 AVENUE TO NORTHWEST
17 AVENUE AS "CARIDAD 'CARY' HERNÁNDEZ STREET"

WHEREAS, Caridad "Cary" Hernández ("Hernández") was born on February 15, 1927 in Cienfuegos, Cuba; and

WHEREAS, Hernández was a resident of the City of Miami ("City") for 62 years upon exiling from Cuba in 1960; and

WHEREAS, Hernández served as executive assistant to the founding members of the Latin Chamber of Commerce ("CAMACOL") in Miami; and

WHEREAS, Hernández assisted and helped thousands of immigrants from all over the world obtain legal status in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Hernández also assisted and registered thousands of United States citizens to become eligible voters in the City; and

WHEREAS, Hernández worked daily in assisting the community with food and clothing distributions to the less fortunate through CAMACOL and St. Juan Bosco Catholic Church in Miami; and

WHEREAS, Hernández passed away on December 29, 2021; and

WHEREAS, in honor of Hernández, the City Commission on January 18, 2022 passed Resolution R-22-0026 codesignating Northwest 3 Street from Northwest 12 Avenue to Northwest 17 Avenue in Miami as "Caridad 'Cary' Hernández Street"; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution R-22-0026 is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Hernández by approving the City's codesignation of that portion of Northwest 3 Street from Northwest 12 Avenue to Northwest 17 Avenue as "Caridad 'Cary' Hernández Street"; and

WHEREAS, Northwest 3 Street from Northwest 12 Avenue to Northwest 17 Avenue is a City-maintained road located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 5,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

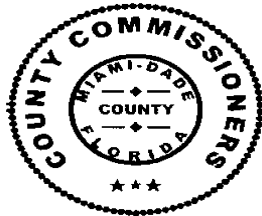
Section 1. Approves the City of Miami's codesignation of that portion of Northwest 3 Street from Northwest 12 Avenue to Northwest 17 Avenue as "Caridad 'Cary' Hernández Street".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami Police Department, and the City of Miami Department of Fire Rescue.

Section 2. The City Commission co-designates that portion within the City's limits of

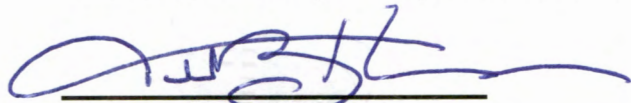
