RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF
RESOLUTION NO. R-62-22 AMENDMENTS TO
IMPLEMENTING ORDER 3-34 FOR 120 DAYS

WHEREAS, at the March 1, 2022 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made directing the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to suspend the implementation of Resolution No. R-62-22 amending Implementing Order 3-34 for 120 days and not requiring the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to provide all reports and findings issued by the Miami-Dade County Office of the Attorney General or Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust regarding any vendor or proposed subcontractor to a selection committee during the term of the suspension to allow for additional time for the County to automate the collection of the necessary records,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board suspends the implementation of Resolution No. R-62-22 amending Implementing Order 3-34 for 120 days from the effective date of this Resolution. The County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee shall not be required to provide all reports and findings issued by the Miami-Dade County Office of the Attorney General or Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust regarding any vendor or proposed subcontractor to a selection committee during this suspension period.

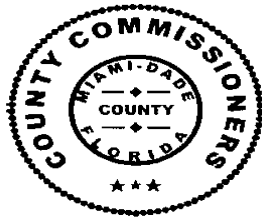
