RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HIALEAH'S
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF EAST PALM
COURT FROM EAST 34 STREET TO EAST 35 STREET AS
"RENE LEOPOLDO RAMOS WAY"

WHEREAS, Rene Leopoldo Ramos ("Ramos") was a Vietnam veteran and a role model
in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, Ramos was always eager to help people and was a Boy Scout in Cuba and
also an altar boy; and

WHEREAS, Ramos served in the Vietnam War in the battle of Hamburger Hill and was
wounded; for his bravery, he received a Purple Heart; and

WHEREAS, Ramos was awarded a Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal,
Infantryman Badge, Marksmanship Badge-Rifle and the National Defense Service Medal; and

WHEREAS, Ramos worked for 35 years in the United States Postal Service; and

WHEREAS, Ramos worked for seven years for the Special Supplemental Nutrition
Program for Women, Infants and Children ("WIC"); and

WHEREAS, in honor of Ramos, the City of Hialeah's Mayor and City Council on
February 22, 2022 passed Resolution No. 2022-025 codesignating East Palm Court from East 34
Street to East 35 Street in Hialeah as "Rene Leopoldo Ramos Way"; and

WHEREAS, the City would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation
on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Ramos by approving the City’s codesignation of that portion of East Palm Court from East 34 Street to East 35 Street in Hialeah as “Rene Leopoldo Ramos Way”; and

WHEREAS, East Palm Court from East 34 Street to East 35 Street is a City-maintained road located in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 13,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

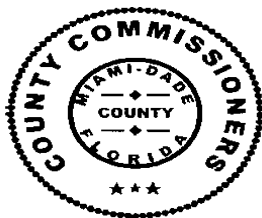
Section 1. Approves the City of Hialeah’s codesignation of that portion of East Palm Court from East 34 Street to East 35 Street as “Rene Leopoldo Ramos Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Hialeah Police Department, and the City of Hialeah Department of Fire Rescue.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator René Garcia. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
