RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI'S REVISED
CODESIGNATION OF NORTHWEST 9TH STREET FROM NW
40TH AVENUE TO NW 42ND AVENUE AS "OFFICER
JORGE SANCHEZ STREET"

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2017, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-969-17, which approved the City of Miami's codesignation of Northwest 9th Street from Northwest 40th Avenue to Northwest 42nd Avenue as "Major Jorge Sanchez Street" in memory of Jorge Sanchez ("Sanchez"), a City of Miami Police Department officer who was tragically killed in an on-duty motorcycle accident on November 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the action taken by this Board, on January 28, 2022, the City of Miami issued a memorandum correcting its earlier codesignation which "inadvertently contained a scrivener's error" with respect to Sanchez's job title, and updated their legislation to reflect that Sanchez was an "Officer," not a "Major"; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the memorandum and revised City of Miami Resolution, numbered R-17-0236, are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Northwest 9th Street from Northwest 40th Avenue to Northwest 42nd Avenue is a city road located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 6; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami would like for the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Sanchez by approving the City of Miami’s revised codesignation of Northwest 9th Street from Northwest 40th Avenue to Northwest 42nd Avenue as “Officer Jorge Sanchez Street”,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

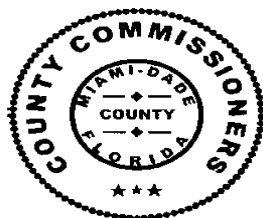
Section 1. Approves the City of Miami’s revised codesignation of Northwest 9th Street from Northwest 40th Avenue to Northwest 42nd Avenue as “Officer Jorge Sanchez Street”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Mayor and Commission of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami Police Department, and the City of Miami Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

At its May 11, 2017 meeting, the City Commission adopted the above-referenced agenda item, RE.6, to codesignate a portion of Northwest 9th Street from Northwest 4th Avenue to Northwest 42nd Avenue, Miami, Florida as “Major Jorge Sanchez Street” to commemorate a City of Miami police officer who was with the City of Miami’s Police Department for 21 years and tragically killed in an on duty motorcycle accident in 2016. The item inadvertently contained a scrivener’s error as his position was actually “Officer” and not “Major”.

The Legislation has been corrected and incremented to Revision B.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION CODESIGNATING NORTHWEST 9TH STREET FROM NORTHWEST 40TH AVENUE TO NORTHWEST 42ND AVENUE, MIAMI, FLORIDA AS "OFFICER JORGE SANCHEZ STREET"; FURTHER DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE HEREIN DESIGNATED OFFICES.

SPONSOR(S): Commissioner Francis Suarez, Commissioner Wifredo (Willy) Gort

WHEREAS, Jorge Sanchez ("Sanchez") began his career with the City of Miami's Police Department ("MPD") in January 1995; and

WHEREAS, Sanchez worked in many specialized units, including but not limited to the Gang Unit, the Missing Persons Unit, the Allapattah Problem Solving Team, the Traffic Enforcement Unit, and the Investigations Division; and

WHEREAS, Sanchez often conveyed to others how proud he was to be a Motorcycle Officer and how he enjoyed working with the other members of the Motorcycle Unit in which he was a part of for the last ten (10) years of his career; and

WHEREAS, Sanchez was tragically killed in an on duty motorcycle accident on November 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Sanchez is survived by his mother, Maria, his former wife, Regla, his fiancée, Evelyn, and his three (3) children, Elizabeth, Jorge, and Officer Eric Sanchez, who followed in his father's footsteps and became a MPD Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

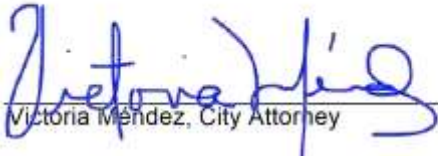
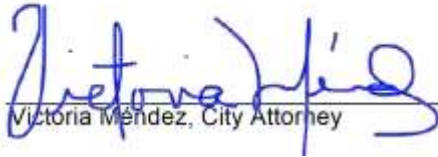
Section 1. The recitals and findings contained in the Preamble to this Resolution are adopted by reference and incorporated as if fully set forth in this Section.

Section 2. Northwest 9th Street from Northwest 40th Avenue to Northwest 42nd Avenue, Miami, Florida, is hereby codesignated as "Officer Jorge Sanchez Street."

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Departments of Police, Fire-Rescue, and Solid Waste; the Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works; the United States Postal Service; and, if a State of Florida road, to the Florida Department of Transportation, District Six, for sign installation within the newly designated roadways.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.¹
