RESOLUTION NO. R-356-22

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF
SOUTHWEST 152ND AVENUE FROM SOUTHWEST 18TH
STREET TO SOUTHWEST 34TH STREET AS “MAS AVENUE”

WHEREAS, Miami Arts Studio 6-12 at Zelda Glazer (“MAS”) is a public magnet school focused on the arts and located at 15015 SW 24th Street, Miami, FL 33185; and

WHEREAS, MAS is one of the foremost schools with a focus on the arts in South Florida; and

WHEREAS, the mission of MAS is to provide performing arts education for students and foster an interest in the arts throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, as an A-rated school, MAS students receive innovative instruction focused on academic achievement and the performing arts; and

WHEREAS, MAS offers students intensive theory and practice in their individual performing arts discipline; and

WHEREAS, Miami Arts Studio’s programs include chorus/vocals, dance, instrumental music, theatre, technical production, broadcasting, and entertainment law; and

WHEREAS, MAS seeks to encourage career-minded students, develop artistic talent and technical skills, offer a rigorous academic and arts curriculum, and prepare students for post-secondary education; and

WHEREAS, Southwest 152nd Avenue from Southwest 18th Street to Southwest 34th Street is a county-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11;
and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor MAS by codesignating that portion of Southwest 152nd Avenue from Southwest 18th Street to Southwest 34th Street as “MAS Avenue”,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

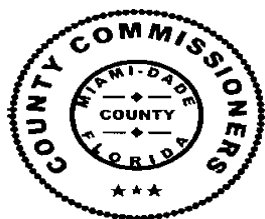
Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of Southwest 152nd Avenue from Southwest 18th Street to Southwest 34th Street as “MAS Avenue”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
