RESOLUTION DECLARING JUNE 24, 2022, AND EACH JUNE  
24 THEREAFTER, AS CHAMPLAIN TOWERS SOUTH-  
SURFSIDE REMEMBRANCE DAY

**WHEREAS**, on June 24, 2021, Champlain Towers South, a 12-story beachfront residential condominium in Surfside, Florida, experienced a major structural collapse; and

**WHEREAS**, the structural collapse of the building tragically resulted in many fatalities among the building's residents and visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, of the 98 individuals whose lives were lost in this tragedy, many were residents of Miami-Dade County and contributed to the fabric of our community; and

**WHEREAS**, families of the victims will gather on June 24, 2022 for a memorial event to honor and pay respects to those who are no longer with us; and

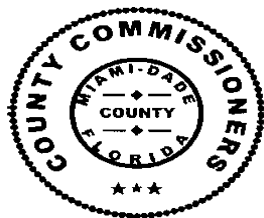
**WHEREAS**, this Board believes it is important to honor and remember the families and victims of the Champlain Towers South collapse in Surfside, and recognize their many contributions to our community,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board hereby declares June 24, 2022, and the day of June 24 each year thereafter, as Champlain Towers South-Surfside Remembrance Day in Miami-Dade County.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Sally A. Heyman. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
