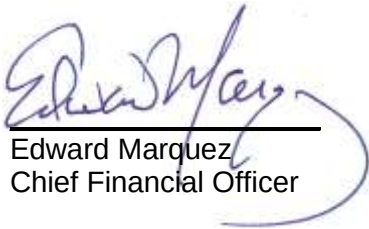

ORDINANCE NO. 22-104

ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MIAMI-DADE
COUNTY INTERFAITH ADVISORY BOARD; CREATING
SECTION 2-227 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE
COUNTY, FLORIDA; ESTABLISHING THE INTERFAITH
ADVISORY BOARD TRUST FUND; PROVIDING
SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN
EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2020, this Board adopted Ordinance No. 20-33, codified at sections 2-221 through 2-226 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, creating the Miami-Dade County Interfaith Advisory Board (IAB) and setting forth its powers and duties; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the IAB is to encourage greater understanding, respect, and cooperation among diverse faith-based, religious, and spiritual groups, institutions, and people in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the IAB currently does not have the ability to accept donations; and

WHEREAS, the ability to accept donations and other funding would give IAB access to resources that would allow IAB to further its work as well as expand its footprint and better fulfill its purpose,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 2-227 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida is hereby created to read as follows:

Sec. 2-227. Financial Support for the Interfaith Advisory Board

There is hereby created the Miami-Dade County Interfaith Advisory Board Trust Fund for the public purposes provided for in this article. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is hereby authorized and directed to establish the Miami-Dade County Interfaith Advisory Board Trust Fund (hereinafter referred to as "Trust Fund") in which will be placed all donations, contributions and funds received by the IAB. All monies in the Trust Fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the provisions of this article. The funds placed into the Trust Fund shall be used only to fund conferences, projects, activities, and special events which further the purposes of the IAB.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
