Recommendation of Tourist Development Council Board Appointment **Subject:**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopt the attached resolution approving the appointment of the following nominee to the Tourist Development Council for the balance of the remaining four-year term expiring in September 2024 for the seat requiring an elected official of the most populous municipality in the county that is subject to the tourist development tax: City of Miami Commissioner Christine King.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

There is no delegated authority for this Tourist Development Council item.

BACKGROUND

On April 4, 1978, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 78-28, as authorized by and pursuant to, section 125.0104, Florida Statutes, to establish the Tourist Development Council (TDC). The Ordinance is codified in sections 2-248 through 2-253.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The Ordinance and Statute specify that the TDC is a nine (9) member volunteer board that includes: one (1) County Commissioner, who is appointed by the chair of the governing Board of the County; two (2) elected municipal officials, at least one of whom must be from the most populous municipality in the County; three (3) owners or operators of motels, hotels, or other tourist accommodations in the County and subject to the tourist development tax; and three (3) persons involved in the tourist industry and have verifiably demonstrated interest in the tourist development of Miami-Dade County but who are not owners or operators of motels, hotels, or other tourist accommodations in the County and are subject to the tourist development tax.

Further, all members of the TDC must be electors of the County and shall serve staggered terms of four years as determined in the appointing resolution. As a result of committee appointments by the City of Miami Commission, the Tourist Development Council was recently notified that the City of Miami Commission designated Commissioner Christine King by resolution to serve as a member of the Council for the seat requiring an elected official of the most populous municipality in the county that is subject to the tourist development tax.

Attached is the City of Miami's resolution designating Commissioner King to be appointed by this Board to the Tourist Development Council and a chart specifically identifying her professional or civic affiliation and designated term.
