Education Village, Inc.

Recommendation

The following waiver of plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This waiver of plat for Education Village, Inc. is bounded on the north by SW 40 Street, on the east approximately 460 feet west of SW 104 Avenue, on the south approximately 125 feet north of SW 40 Terrace, and on the west approximately 610 feet east of SW 107 Avenue.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this waiver of plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources; Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

A location sketch is attached to this memorandum as Exhibit A.

Legal description of the boundaries of the land are on file with the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

This waiver of plat is located in Commission District 10, which is represented by Senator Javier D. Souto.

- Available public water and sewer lines abut the proposed subdivision. The parcel is required to connect to public water and public sanitary sewers.



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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE WAIVER OF PLAT OF EDUCATION VILLAGE. INC.. D-24770. **FILED EDUCATION** VILLAGE, INC., LOCATED IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 54 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY SW 40 STREET, ON THE EAST APPROXIMATELY 460 FEET WEST OF SW 104 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 125 FEET NORTH OF SW 40 TERRACE, AND ON THE WEST APPROXIMATELY 610 FEET EAST OF SW 107 AVENUE)

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Education Village, Inc., a Florida corporation, has this day presented to this Board a waiver of plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said waiver of plat of the property legally described as Lot 1, Block 1, "Heftler Homes Section One," according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 65, at Page 149, and a portion of Blk. 1, "Subdivision of Section 20 and West 1/2 of Section 28 for the Dade County Development Company," according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 169, both of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, lying and being in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 20, Township 54 South, Range 40 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said waiver of plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that said waiver of plat is hereby approved; that the property has been found to be in compliance with chapter 28, Subdivisions, of the Miami-Dade County Code; that approval of this waiver of plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations; and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this waiver of plat conforms to those requirements.
