RESOLUTION URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENACT S. 3609, H.R. 6787, THE GAS PRICES RELIEF ACT OF 2022, OR SIMILAR LEGISLATION THAT WOULD PROVIDE A FEDERAL GAS TAX HOLIDAY

**WHEREAS**, the average price for a gallon of regular unleaded gasoline in the U.S. was approximately \$5.01 as of June 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, according to data from the U.S. Energy Information Administration, this represents an increase of more than 50 percent over the previous 12-months, and an increase of more than 100 percent since the first week of 2021; and

WHEREAS, this sharp rise in the cost of gas at the pumps represents an unprecedented burden on American families; and

WHEREAS, current indicators suggest that this steady increase in the average price of gas could continue into the near future; and

**WHEREAS**, the federal government levies a tax of 18.4 cents on every gallon of gas sold in the United States; and

WHEREAS, providing for a federal gas tax holiday would be one way to lower energy prices for the average American, including residents of and visitors to Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, according to data from the Federal Highway Administration, a suspension of the federal gas tax would save the average American more than \$100.00 per year; and

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2022, United States Senator Mark Kelly (D-Arizona) introduced S. 3609, a bill entitled the Gas Prices Relief Act of 2022, for consideration during the 117th Congress; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 18, 2022, United States Representative Tom O'Halleran (D-Arizona) introduced H.R. 6787, a companion bill to S. 3609; and

WHEREAS, if enacted, the Gas Prices Relief Act of 2022 would amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code") to, among other things, set the rate of tax under section 4081(a)(2)(A)(i) of the Code to zero for all gasoline removed, entered, or sold on or after the date of enactment of the Act and before January 1, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board wishes to support the Gas Prices Relief Act of 2022, or similar legislation that would provide a federal gas tax holiday,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the United States Congress to enact S. 3609, H.R. 6787, the Gas Prices Relief Act of 2022, or similar legislation that would provide a federal gas tax holiday.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to Senator Mark Kelly, Representative Tom O'Halleran, and the members of the Florida Congressional Delegation.

Section 3. Directs the County's federal lobbyists to advocate for the legislative action set forth in section 1, above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2022 Federal Legislative Package to include this item.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Danielle Cohen Higgins.

It was offered by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Danielle Cohen Higgins and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
