RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FY 2021-22 DISTRICT
13 ALLOCATION OF FEES COLLECTED FOR ISSUING
PARKING PERMITS TO GLORIA M. SILVERIO
FOUNDATION, INCORPORATED IN THE AMOUNT
OF \$5,000.00

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 13-11 provides that one-third of fees collected for issuing parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers shall be distributed to private not-for-profit, non-denominational agencies providing services for severely abused or neglected children on a countywide basis, throughout all of Miami-Dade County, for a countywide purpose; and

WHEREAS, Gloria M. Silverio Foundation, Incorporated is a private 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, non-denominational entity that is dedicated to eliminating the ultimate in infant abuse, abandonment, through education, prevention, direct assistance and grassroots community involvement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Implementing Order 4-100, each time that one-third of the fees collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers equals \$130,000.00, each Commission district shall be apportioned \$10,000.00 for allocation (“stroller allocation”); and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade County to provide funding in the amount of \$5,000.00 to Gloria M. Silverio Foundation, Incorporated,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

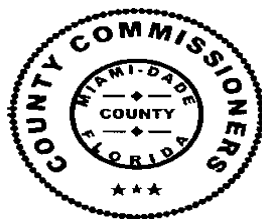
Section 1. The foregoing recitals are approved and incorporated herein in its entirety.

Section 2. This Board hereby approves the allocation to Gloria M. Silverio Foundation, Incorporated in the amount of \$5,000.00, and directs the County Mayor or the Mayor's designee to distribute funds collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers as provided herein from the FY 2021-22 District 13 stroller allocation.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator René García. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
