**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving the waiver

## RESOLUTION NO. R-1193-21

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE WAIVER OF FORMAL BID PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO SECTION 5.03(D) OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER AND SECTION 2-8.1(B) OF THE CODE IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH AGREEMENTS, BY TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF MEMBERS PRESENT; DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE FORWARD LOOKING LONG FINANCIAL RELIEF AMENDMENTS WITH URW AIRPORTS LLC, SMARTE CARTE, INC., SAFE WRAP OF FLORIDA JV, LLC, REACH TV, MIAMI AIRPORT CONCESSION, LLC, ELECTRONIC SERVICES, INC., COMMUNITEL, INC., AND IMCMV MIA AIRPORT LLC CONSISTENT WITH THE LONG TERM FINANCIAL RELIEF PROVIDED TO THE OTHER CONCESSIONAIRES WITHIN MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE FORWARD LOOKING LONG TERM FINANCIAL RELIEF WITH TENANTS AT THE RENTAL CAR CENTER; DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO TERMINATE ALL ONGOING PROCUREMENTS FOR PROCUREMENT LUGGAGE CARTS OR **STANDALONE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINES** ΑT MIAMI **INTERNATIONAL** AIRPORT; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO SUCH AGREEMENTS WITHOUT NEED FOR OF THE FURTHER ACTION BOARD OF COUNTY **COMMISSIONERS** 

WHEREAS, at the November 10, 2021 Chairman's Council of Policy, a motion was made directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide forward looking long term relief to additional commercial tenants at Miami International Airport, consistent with the long term relief ultimately approved by the Board of County Commissioners for other concessionaires at Miami International Airport, contingent on the County Mayor recommending the waiver of competitive bidding requirements as needed to accomplish such amendments; and

WHEREAS, the County Mayor has recommended the waiver of competitive bidding requirements pursuant to section 5.03(d) of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter in connection with amendments to the additional commercial tenants at Miami International Airport and the Rental Car Center referenced below, and a copy of such recommendation is currently on file with the Clerk of Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. For the reasons discussed at the November 10, 2021 Chairman's Council of Policy, and for the reasons proffered in the County Mayor's written recommendation, this Board determines that the waiver of competitive bidding in connection with the negotiation and execution of amendments for the identified concessionaires at Miami International Airport is in the best interest of Miami-Dade County and waives, by two-thirds vote of members present, the formal bid procedures pursuant to section 5.03(d) of the Home Rule Charter and the requirements of section 2-8.1(b) of the Code.

Section 2. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to negotiate forward looking long term financial relief amendments with URW Airports LLC, Smarte Carte, Inc., Safe Wrap of Florida JV, LLC, Reach TV, Miami Airport Concession, LLC, Electronic Media Services, Inc., Communitel, Inc., and IMCV MIA Airport LLC consistent with the financial relief provided to the other concessionaires within Miami International Airport, subject to compliance with the requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration, the Airport Amended and Restated Trust Agreement, and bond covenants.

Section 3. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to negotiate forward looking long term financial relief amendments with tenants of the Rental Car Center, subject to compliance with the requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration, the Airport Amended and Restated Trust Agreement, the Transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act loan, and the Rental Car Center Operating Agreement, and bond covenants.

Section 4. This Board authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to negotiate and enter into the amendments specified in sections 2 and 3 above, except to the extent such amendments are materially inconsistent with the terms of the long term relief approved by this Board for other concessionaires at Miami International Airport.

Section 5. The County Mayor is hereby directed to terminate all ongoing procurements for luggage carts or standalone automated teller machines for use at Miami International Airport and reject all proposals received in connection with such procurements.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner Oliver G. Gilbert, III, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sally A. Heyman and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
